#### **ORDER :**

B-231/86, dated the 18<sup>th</sup> April 1986 at pages 304-308 of Part III-Section 1 (b) of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette, dated the 21<sup>st</sup> May 1986:-

2. The amendments hereby made shall come into force on the 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2009.

### AMENDMENTS

In the said Rule,-

(ii) Must possess experience for ten years as Orthotic Technicians/Vocational Instructor;

(iii) Must possess experience for fifteen Years as Multipurpose Rehabilitation Aide in District Rehabilitation Centres of State Commissionerate for the Disabled Department.”;

(A) against the entry “ 2 Vocational Instructors” in column (1), the entry “By direct recruitment” shall be inserted in column (2) as so inserted;

### ORDER:-

The Government in its orders first, second and third read above, have accorded sanction for the creation of 27 posts of Recaners at the rate of one post in each District Rehabilitation Centre except Chennai and Madurai. Initially, their honorarium was fixed

at Rs.800/- <sup>per month</sup> p.m. each. After increase of honorarium thrice, the Recaners were given a non-standardised scale of pay of Rs.1750-20-2050. This was enhanced to Rs.2100 – 30 – 2400 . Now as per the Government order eighth read above they have been given a regular standardized scale of pay of Rs.2550-55-2660-60-3200, accepting their demand to enable them to become regular Government servants.

2. The State Special Commissioner for the Disabled, Chennai in his letter ninth read above, has sent proposals for issue of adhoc rules for the post of Visually Handicapped Recaner in the District Rehabilitation Centres. The Government accept the proposal. The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazettee.

### NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following rules:-

2. The rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 17<sup>th</sup> June 2005.

### RULES

The General Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in the Tamil Nadu General Subordinate Service shall apply to the holder of the temporary post of Visually Handicapped Recaner in the District Rehabilitation Centres, sanctioned from time to time, in the Department of Rehabilitation of the Disabled, subject to the modifications specified in the following rules:-

**2. Constitution:-** The post shall constitute a distinct class in the said service.

**3. Appointment:-** Appointment to the post shall be made by direct recruitment from among the Visually Handicapped persons.

**4. The Appointing Authority:-** The appointing authority for the post shall be the State Commissioner for the Disabled, Chennai.

**5. Qualification:-**

(a) Age – No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post, if he has completed, or will complete forty years of age on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.

(b) Other qualification – No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post unless he possesses the following qualifications namely:-

(i) Must have passed VIII standard of a recognized school (i.e.) a school maintained by or opened with the sanction of the Government of Tamil Nadu or to which recognition has been accorded by the Director of School Education, under the Tamil Nadu Educational Rules ; and

(ii) Must have put in experience for a period of not less than one year in the recaning of chairs, etc.

**6. Reservation of appointment:-** The rule relating to reservation of appointments (General Rule 22) shall apply for appointment to the post by direct recruitment.

**7. Probation:-** Every person appointed to the post by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

**8. Pay:-** There shall be paid to the holders of the post, a monthly pay calculated in the scale of pay of Rs.2550-55-2660-60-3200.

**9. Saving:-** Nothing contained in these rules shall adversely affect the interests of person holding the post on the date of issue of these rules.

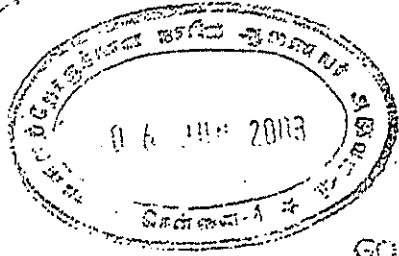



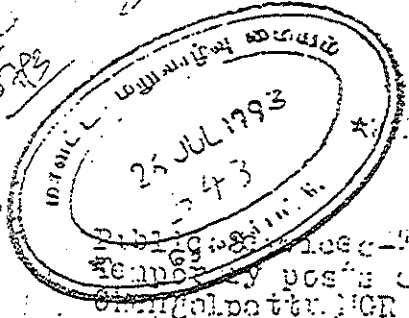

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ORDER:

In G.O.Ms.No.1936, Education, dated 8.11.66, the Government sanctioned the establishment of a Regional Braille press in the Government school for the Blind, Poonamallee and sanctioned,

2. The following notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government gazette:-

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the power conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following rules:-

The rules hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 3rd February 1968.

RULES

The General and special rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in the Madras stationery and printing service shall apply to the holder of the temporary post of manager Regional Braille press attached to the Government School for the Blind, Poonamallee, subject to the modifications specified in the following rules.

2. Constitution:- of the said service.

The post shall constitute a separate category

3. Appointment:-

Appointment to the post shall be made as follows:-

- i) Recruitment by transfer from (a) stereo type operator or (b) copy holders in the Regional Braille press who have put in service for a period of at least 10 years in such posts; or
- ii) By transfer from the category of Assistant works Manager in the Stationery and Printing service or
- iii) If no qualified and suitable person is available for appointment by methods (i) and (ii) above appointment shall be made by direct recruitment.

Qualification:-

AGE: No person shall be eligible for appointment by direct recruitment if he has completed or will complete the age of 30 years on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.

OTHER QUALIFICATIONS:- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post unless he possesses the following qualifications

- (a) (i) A degree of a University with Tamil Under Part II  
 (ii) A diploma in Printing Technology (L.P.T) issued by the Technological Diploma Examination Board or state Board of Technical Education and Training Madras
- (b) (ii) A diploma in printing Technology (L.P.T.) issued by the Technological Diploma Examination Board of Technical Examination and Training Madras  
 (iii) Compositor's work (lower Grade)  
 (iv) Machine work (Higher Grade)  
 (i) A complete S.S.L.C.

Preference shall be given to those who possess the following qualifications.

- (i) Good knowledge of Bharathi and Standard English Braille  
 (ii) Two years experience in Rehabilitating or teaching, the blind involving reading and writing Braille.

6. PROBATION:

Every person appointment to the post shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

7. TESTS:\*

A Probationer shall within the period of his probation pass the Account Test for executive Officers

8. PAY :-

There shall be paid to the holder of the post a monthly pay calculated in the scale of Rs.550-25-600-35-950
