1. Candidates can apply seeking revaluation of their valued answer scripts (Theory only) in respect of the following four subjects only. Physics (005), Chemistry (007), Biology (009) and Mathematics (041).
 2. Correct and complete particulars should be given for each and every column found in the application.
 3. Fee prescribed for revaluation in each subject is Ra. 402/- including service charge of Ra. 2/-
 4. Mode of payment of fee:—
 - (a) **For Motuvel Candidates:** To remit the fee into the treasury/sub-treasury under the following head of account.
 - (b) **Candidates from Chennai City:** Chennai City candidates should obtain the D.D. from any of the branches of State Bank of India or from any one of the Nationalised Banks in Chennai, favouring the "Additional Secretary (H.S.) to the Director of Government Examinations, Chennai-6". Candidates should write their full name, Registrar No. and complete residential address on the back side of the D.D. without fail.
- Note: Cheque/Indian Postal Orders will not be accepted.
5. The following documents should be enclosed along with the application:—
 1. Xerox Copy of the Mark Certificate.
 2. Original treasury cheque/Bank D.D. as the case may be.
 6. The Filled up application for Revaluation, should not be sent to this office directly. But the same should be handed over in person in time (within the date notified by this department) from where they received the application form.
 7. Application received after the date & time notified will, summarily be rejected.
 8. Fee once remitted will not be refunded or adjusted under any circumstances.
 9. Those who have duly applied in time and obtained the Xerox copy of answer sheet above are eligible to apply for revaluation.
 10. After seeing the xerox copy of answer script, if any candidate wants to apply for retotalling for the rectification of totalling error noticed or for revaluation they can do so for both separately. But they should specifically apply for the same within the due date by remitting the prescribed fee therein.
 11. On revaluation if the increase or decrease in mark is less than 3 (Three) the same will not be considered. However if it is 3 (Three) and above, the same will be effected in both ways. (i.e. either upward revision or downward revision) and a new mark certificate will be accordingly issued to candidates cancelling the earlier one.
 12. The above rule will not be applicable to failed candidates. Hence the actual mark arrived at the revaluation will be effected.
 13. Change in Marks on account of revaluation will be intimated to the candidates by Telegram only.
 14. The failed candidates and candidates who want to apply for improvement should submit their application for appearing the next session of examination within the due date even if the results of revaluation has not been received by them at that time.
