**CITIZEN CHARTER: 2008– 2009**

Cultivation of mulberry and rearing of silkworm crop generates employment with periodic returns through cocoon crops. To improve the economic conditions of the farmers, Government will continue to support the development of Sericulture activities in the State.

- The farmers are motivated to plant high yielding mulberry variety.
- The farmers are motivated to take up bivoltine crops.
- Farmers are motivated to rear silkworm by using shoot rearing racks.
- Farmers are assisted to construct separate rearing house and procurement of improved rearing equipments.
- Farmers are assisted to install drip irrigation system in mulberry garden.
- Farmers are assisted to purchase quality disinfecting materials.
- Farmers are assisted to establish chawkie rearing building and procurement of equipments.
- Reelers are assisted to install multiend reeling machines.
- Reelers are assisted to establish cottage basin reeling units.
- Reelers are assisted to establish twisting units.
- Reelers are provided incentive for production of bivoltine silk.
- Sericulturists are motivated to undergo training in the following areas
  - Integrated nutrient and disease management in Mulberry.
  - Young age silkworm rearing.
  - Composite silkworm rearing.
  - Integrated pest and disease management.
  - Silkworm seed production.
  - Value addition to bye-products of sericulture industry by better resource management.
