ORDER:-

As per the Special Rules issued in the Government Order first cited, the post of Municipal Commissioner, Grade-II comes under the Tamil Nadu Municipal Commissioners' Subordinate Service. The appointment to the post shall be made inter-alia;

"by direct recruitment from among persons who have served as Manager of all Municipal offices or as Accountant and Revenue Officer of all Municipalities, except the Second Grade Municipalities for a total period of not less than three years on duty in the Tamil Nadu Municipal General Service".

2. The Tamil Nadu Municipal Employees Union has represented that the Municipal Employees initially appointed as Junior Assistant in Municipalities reach the cadre of Manager after putting in a long service and at the age of above 50 years they could not appear for the competitive examination conducted by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission for selection as Municipal Commissioner, Grade-II. They have, therefore, requested the Government to appoint the Municipal Employees as Municipal Commissioner, Grade-II directly without appearing for the examination conducted by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission.

3. The Government have examined the request of the Tamil Nadu Municipal Employees Union in detail and have decided to revise the procedure of recruitment of Municipal Employees in the Tamil Nadu Municipal Commissioners' Subordinate Service to the cadre of Municipal Commissioner, Grade-II.

4. In this connection, the Director of Municipal Administration has sent proposals to amend the Special Rules for Tamil Nadu Municipal Commissioners' Subordinate Service in his letter sixth read above. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Municipal Administration and they have decided to accept it. Accordingly, a decision has been arrived at to recruit the Municipal Employees from Class-I and IA of Tamil Nadu Municipal General Service as Municipal Commissioner, Grade-II through Selection by a Committee consisting of the following officials:-

The Director/Commissioner of Municipal Administration. Chairman.

The second level officer of the Directorate/ Commissionerate of Municipal Administration in charge of the Municipal Commissioners' establishment. Member/Secretary.

An officer nominated by the Secretary to Government, Municipal Administration & Water Supply Department. Member.

Based on the recommendations of above Selection Committee, the Government in Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department shall make appointments to the post of Municipal Commissioner, Grade-II after obtaining the concurrence of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission.

5. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Municipal Administration, direct that the Municipal Employees belonging to Class-I and IA in the Tamil Nadu Municipal General Service be appointed as Municipal Commissioner, Grade-II by adopting the method of "Selection", in which the senior-most persons fit for promotion from among them will be selected through the Selection Committee mentioned at para 4 above by suitable assessment. The Government shall make these appointments after obtaining the concurrence of the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission. Accordingly, the Government have decided to amend the Special rules for the Tamil Nadu Municipal Commissioners' Subordinate Service suitably.

6. The appended Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette.

APPENDIX.
NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Municipal Commissioners' Subordinate Service (Section 23 B of Volume III of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual, 1970).

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 15th March 2004.

AMENDMENTS

In the said Special Rules,-

(1) in rule 2, for clause (a), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

"(a) By direct recruitment from among the categories of Municipal Employees in Class-I or Class-I 'A' of the Tamil Nadu Municipal General Service and the candidates to be appointed shall be selected based on seniority and assessment by a Selection Committee consisting of the following officials:-

The Director/Commissioner of Municipal Administration. Chairman.

The second level officer of the Directorate/Commissionerate of Municipal Administration in-charge of the Municipal Commissioners' establishment. Member Secretary.

An officer nominated by the Secretary to Government, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department. Member.

Provided that the appointment shall be made by the Government with the concurrence of the Commission.

Provided also that the guidelines followed in respect of selection through Departmental Promotion Committee be followed by the Selection Committee."

(2) in rule 4, in the Table, in column (1), for item (a), the following item shall be substituted, namely:-

"(a) By direct recruitment from the categories of Municipal Employees in Class I or Class I A of the Tamil Nadu Municipal General Service."

(3) in rule 5, after the expression "15th March of every year", the following expression shall be added, namely: -

"for the purpose of recruiting Municipal Employees as Municipal Commissioner, Grade-II by direct recruitment through a Selection Committee specifically constituted for the purpose, the crucial date on which the Municipal Employees should possess the prescribed qualifications shall be 15th March of every year."

(4) in rule 6, after the words "Open Market" the words "or from among Municipal Employees" shall be inserted :

(5) in rule 7, after the words "Open Market" the words "or from among Municipal Employees" shall be inserted.
