ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Managing Director / Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has been appointed as Nodal Officer for Rajiv Awas Yojana programme to take up Survey of Slums in Chennai and Madurai Cities and to Co-ordinate with Ministry of Housing and Urban Poverty Alleviation, Government of India to pursue the agenda of Slum free cities and Slum free State under Rajiv Awas Yojana in Tamil Nadu.

2. In the reference second read above, the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has reported that, the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board itself have to prepare Slum wise, City wise, Zone wise plan of action based on the socio economic survey, which broadly involve mapping of all the slums and identification of development model for each slum. Initially it is proposed to take up a Survey on development of the slums in Chennai and Madurai.

3. Since the slum survey works are to be commenced in Chennai and Madurai and the Plan of Action has to be sent to Government of India and hence the Government of India has provided a sum of Rs.480.14 Lakhs. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board has therefore requested the Government to release the same to Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board for carrying out the slum survey in Chennai and Madurai initially under Rajiv Awas Yojana.

4. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board and decided to accept it. Accordingly sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.4,80,14,000/- (Rupees Four crores eighty lakhs

and fourteen thousand only) to carryout the above said survey works at once by Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board in Chennai and Madurai. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is requested to ensure the guidelines of Government of India should be observed while implementation of Rajiv Awas Yojana Scheme in Tamil Nadu.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following new head of account opened under D.No.26.08

"2216. Housing – 02 – Urban Housing – 190 – Assistance to Public Sector and other undertakings – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan – VI. Schemes shared between State and Centre – U.A – Slum Survey Programme under Rajiv Awas Yojana – 09. Grants – in – Aid -03 Grants for Specific Schemes.

6. The Secretary, Housing and Urban Development Department is the Estimating , Reconciling and Controlling Authority for the above new Sub head of Account. The Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officer concerned are requested to open the above new sub head of account in their books.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of 'New Service' for which approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval the expenditure will initially be met by drawl of advance from contingency fund, orders for which will be issued from Finance (BG.I) Department. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is authorized to apply for Contingency Fund in Finance (BG.I) Department in the prescribed format along with the copy of this order and requested to send a draft explanatory note to Finance Department for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2010-2011.

8. The Commissioner of Treasuries and Accounts, Chennai is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 4 above by means of an account payee cheque in favour of Personal Deposit Account of the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board indicating the account number thereon and disburse the same to the Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board so as to enable it to remit the same in State Bank of India, Thousand Lights Branch, Chennai.

9. The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board is requested to accord the Utilization Certificate along with Statement of Expenditure to the Government.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.75531/Hg/10 dated 10.1.2011 and ASL No.1752 (One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fifty Two).


