ORDER:

In the G.O. second read above orders were issued according administrative approval, among others, to the following Solid Waste Management projects with the funding pattern as indicated below:-

2. Now the Commissioner of Municipal Administration has stated that both the Madurai and Coimbatore Corporation Councils have passed resolution stating that the respective local bodies would adopt the Public Private Partnership structure and that the 30% Corporation contribution would be met by following the Public Private Partnership mode. Both these resolutions have been forwarded by the respective Corporation Commissioners and they have in effect stated that there is no need to go in for the loan as ordered in the G.O.(D) No.160, Municipal Administration and Water Supply Department, dated 17.4.2007, and the Public Private Partnership mode shall be adopted as per the resolution. The Government of India have also agreed to this arrangements.

3. The Commissioner of Municipal Administration has recommended the proposals received from the two Corporations for the issue of necessary amendments to the G.O.(D)No.160, Municipal Administration and Water Supply

(MA.II) Department, dated 17.4.2007 and sought for orders of Government in the matter.

4. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Municipal Administration at para 3 above and they, ^{also} super session of the orders issued in G.O.(D)No.160, Municipal Administration and Water Supply (MA.II) Department, dated 17.4.2007 accord administrative approval for implementation of the projects sent by the Corporations of Madurai and Coimbatore as proposed in para 1 above by following Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode as under;
