ORDER:

Due to the cyclone "NISHA" and consequent heavy rains all over the State during November 2008, widespread damages have been caused to infrastructure, community owned assets besides loss of lives, crops, etc.

2) Considering the vast number of people affected, damages to infrastructure, etc., the Government in their orders second cited, among other things, have sanctioned an amount of Rs.25 Crores to Urban Local Bodies for restoration of Water Supply Schemes and to undertake urgent repairs to Roads and Street Lights. The Government have also authorised the Principal Secretary / Commissioner of Revenue Administration to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned.

3) Based on the extent of damages caused to Urban Local Bodies, the Director, Municipal Administration, Chepauk, Chennai-5, in his reference third cited, has requested to allot funds to the tune of Rs.25 Crores to the

District Collectors with reference to the Government Order second cited as follows:

4) Considering the request of the Director, Municipal Administration, a sum of Rs.25 Crores (Rupees Twenty Five Crores only) is hereby released to the above Collectors for restoration of water supply schemes and to undertake urgent repairs to roads and street lights in Urban Local Bodies. The above Collectors are also authorised to accord administrative sanction / draw and disburse the amount sanctioned.

5) While sanctioning administrative approval, the districts Collectors are directed to ensure that the total administrative approvals / sanctions accorded by them to Urban Local Bodies / Municipalities for the current spell of rains (19.11.2008 to 28.11.2008) does not exceed the above allotment.

6) The Director, Municipal Administration is requested to furnish the list of works to be taken up for restoration to the Collectors concerned and to issue detailed guidelines in this regard. He is also requested to ensure that the restoration of assets of Urban Local Bodies damaged due to heavy rains / floods consequent on the Cyclone "NISHA" alone be taken up.

7) Necessary funds will be provided in RE / FMA 2008-09. The expenditure shall be debited to the following Heads of Account:

They are also requested to include the above said expenditure while sending RE / FMA proposal for 2008 – 09 without fail.

10) The above Collectors are requested to send Utilisation Certificate for the amounts allotted to them to the Accountant General / Government and to this office early.

(DPC 2245 02 102 AB 1813).


