Forests - Establishment – Welfare of Ex-Servicemen – Reservation of vacancies for Ex-Servicemen for appointment as Forest Guard / Forest Watcher in the Forest Department Orders – Issued.

ORDER:

At the 43rd Meeting of the Tamil Nadu Soldiers', Sailors' and Airmen's Board held at Madras on 19.12.1978 it was resolved that reservation of 10% of vacancies should be made for Ex-Servicemen for appointment as Forest Guard / Forest Watchers in the Forest Department by relaxing the age limit, provided they are otherwise qualified. The Joint Director, Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare, Madras has requested that the Board's decision may be considered. The Chief Conservator of Forests has sent proposals to Government based on the decision of the Board and the proposal of the Joint Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare.

2. The Government after detailed examination accept the proposals of the Chief Conservator of Forests and direct that 10 percent of the vacancies for direct recruitment to the posts of Forest Guards and 5% of the vacancies for the posts of Forest Watchers included in the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Forest Subordinate Service be reserved for Ex-Servicemen, by relaxing the age limit provided they are otherwise qualified. The Government also direct that the allocation of seats to the Ex-Servicemen will not be a reservation as contemplated under Article 15 or 16 of the Constitution, but it would constitute the source or recruitment. In other words, the 11th, 21st, 31st etc., position of recruitment in both the categories will be from Ex-Servicemen belonging to the communities indicated against these serial numbers in the roster.

3. The Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to send necessary draft amendment to the Special Rules for the Tamil Nadu Forest Subordinate Service immediately.
