ORDER:

In the Government order second read above, the Government have decided to accord priority for purpose of sponsoring through Employment Exchanges to one dependant of Ex-Servicemen, provided that the Ex-Servicemen himself has not utilised the priority for himself and in pursuance of the above decision, amendment to the Government order first read above have been issued by incorporating the following entries under item (1) under Group II of the above Government Order among others. "One son or or one daughter or one dependent of Ex-Servicemen provided that the concerned ex-Servicemen themselves have not utilised the priority".

2. The Director of Employment and Training has not implemented the orders issued in the above order. He has indicated certain practical difficulties in implementing the above orders and required certain amendment to the said Government Order. He has, therefore in his letter third read above sent proposals for amending the Government Order first read above after getting the

approval of the Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare for effectively implementing the instructions contained thereon.

3. The Government after careful consideration accept the proposal of the Director of Employment and Training as approved by the Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare.

4. The following amendment is issued to G.O.Ms.No.188, Personnel & Administrative Reforms (Personnel-P), dated 28.12.1976.

AMENDMENT

"In the list of priority categories annexed to the said Government Order for the existing item (i) Under Group II the following shall be substituted:

- i) Ex-Servicemen and wives, sons and unmarried daughters of serving military personnel and one son or one daughter or wife or one dependant or the widow of Ex-Servicemen provided that the concerned Ex-Servicemen themselves have not utilised the priority.

(Ex-Serviceman means a person, who after having served for any period of time in the Defence Services (Indian Army, Indian Air Force, Indian Navy, the Auxillary Forces of India and the Boys companies) has been discharged; (that one who has been dismissed by a competent authority or one who has been discharged on account of misconduct or inefficiency before completing six months service shall not be treated as Ex-Serviceman).

EXPLANATIONS:

1. A Dependent of Ex-Servicemen is one who has been so identified and certified by the Assistant Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare of the district of which the dependent is a native. The certificate shall be issued in the form annexed.
2. When the certificate of dependency is issued by the Assistant Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare, necessary entries should be made in the discharge certificate of the Ex-Servicemen concerned.
3. The responsibility of deciding as to who should enjoy the priority, the Ex-Serviceman or his dependent should be decided by the Assistant Director of Ex-Servicemen's Welfare concerned in consultation with the Ex-Serviceman himself, after obtaining a written declaration from the individual.

4. The grant of this concession will take effect from 22nd November 1984.
5. The priority concession to the dependents will be given even if the Ex-Serviceman is expired.
6. The Assistant Director of Ex-Servicemen Welfare concerned will render a monthly periodical to the Employment Office concerned in the district giving full details of the Ex-Serviceman in whose cases, dependency certificates have been issued.
7. This concession of priority to dependents of Ex-Servicemen will not, however, affect the other concession of age etc., for which the Ex-Servicemen are eligible under the Central and State Governments.
8. The Ex-Servicemen will continue to enjoy the priority under the Government of India and any concession availed of by them under the Government of India will not be taken into account for purpose of this Government Order.
