ORDER:

The following Notification will be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following rules.

2. The rules hereby made shall come into force on the June 1984.

6th

RULES

The General Rules applicable to the holders of the permanent posts in the Tamil Nadu General Subordinate Service shall apply to the holders of the temporary post of Welfare Organiser sanctioned from time to time for the Department of Ex-servicemen's Welfare subject to the modifications specified in the following rules.

2. Constitution: The post shall constitute a separate category in a distinct class of the said service.

3. Appointment : The appointment to the post shall be made

- i. by direct recruitment from among the military pensioners; or
- ii. by recruitment by transfer from among the holders of the post of Assistant in the Department of Ex-servicemen's Welfare.

Explanation:- Appointment to the post by direct recruitment and by recruitment by transfer shall be in the ratio of 4:1. If no qualified and suitable candidates are available for appointment to the post by direct recruitment, the vacancies shall be filled up temporarily by recruitment by transfer and if so qualified and suitable candidates is available for appointment to the post by recruitment by transfer, the vacancies shall be filled up temporarily by direct recruitment.

4. Appointing Authority:- The appointing authority for the post shall be the Joint Director of Ex-servicemen's Welfare.

5. Qualifications:-

- (a) Age:- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by direct recruitment, if he has completed or will complete 53 years of age in the case of persons belonging to the Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes and the Backward Classes and 48 years of age in the case of persons other than those belonging to the Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes and the Backward Classes on the first day of July of the year in which the selection for appointment is made.
- (b) b) Other qualifications:- No person shall be eligible for appointment to the post by the methods specified in column (1) of the Table below unless he possesses the qualifications specified in the corresponding entries in column (2) thereof.

6 . Probation: - Every person appointed to the post by direct recruitment shall, from the date on which he joins duty, be on probation for a total period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years.

6A. Test: - Every person appointed to the post by direct recruitment shall pass the

District Office Manual
and

the Account Test for Subordinate Officers Part-I within the period of probation;

Provided that a person holding the post on the date of coming into force of this rule shall pass the said test within a period of 3 years from the date of coming into force of this rule failing which his services will be terminated

7. Rule of reservation:- The rule relating to reservation of appointments (General Rule 22) shall apply for appointment to the post by direct recruitment.

8. Method of selection:- Selection of candidates for appointment to the post by direct recruitment shall be made by a Selection Committee consisting of the following persons, namely:-

Provided that the absence of a member, other than the Chairman, shall not invalidate the proceedings of the Selection Committee if more than half the members of the Selection Committee were present in a meeting.

9. Pay:- There shall be paid to the holders of the post a monthly pay calculated in the scale of Rs.525-25-675-30-855-35-925.
