### **ORDER:**

The State Data Centre (SDC) has been identified as one of the important element of the core infrastructure for supporting e-Governance initiatives of National e-Governance Plan (NeGP). Under NeGP, it is proposed to create State Data Centres for the States to consolidate services, applications and infrastructure to provide efficient electronic delivery of Government to Government(G2G), Government to Citizen(G2C) and Government to Business(G2B) services. These services can be rendered by the States through common delivery platform seamlessly supported by core connectivity infrastructure such as State Wide Area Network (SWAN) and Common Service Centre (CSC) connectivity extended up to Village level. State Data Centre would provide many functionalities and some of the key functionalities are Central Repository of the State, Secure Data Storage, Online Delivery of Services, Citizen Information / Services Portal, State Intranet Portal, Disaster Recovery, Remote Management and Service Integration.

2. The Managing Director, ELCOT in his letter first read above has sent a proposal for establishing the State Data Centre at ELCOT Perungudi Complex in Chennai and requested the Government to issue formal orders for its implementation. An advance copy of the Detailed project report was sent to Government of India for its approval.

3. In the letter second read above, the Government of India(GOI) has accorded Administrative approval for the State Data Centre project at a total estimated outlay of Rs.55.80 crores (Rupees fifty five crores and eighty lakhs only) spread over a period of five years. The Department of Information Technology (DIT),

Government of India contribution is Rs.18.41 crores (Rupees eighteen crores and forty one lakhs only) and Rs.37.39 crores (Rupees thirty seven crores and thirty nine lakhs only) to be met through Additional Central Assistance (ACA) for National e-Governance Plan (NeGP) provision of Planning Commission.

4. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Managing Director, ELCOT and decided to accept the proposal for establishing the State Data Centre at a total estimated cost of Rs.55,80,00,000/- (Rupees fifty five crores and eighty lakhs only) approved by the Government of India. Accordingly, the Government hereby accord administrative sanction for the establishment of the State Data Centre at an estimated cost of **Rs.55.80 crores** (Rupees fifty five crores and eighty lakhs only) funded by Government of India, spread over a period of five years and nominate ELCOT as the project implementing agency.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No.43064/Ind/08, dated 24.07.2008.
