ORDER:

The Common Service Centres (CSCs) are envisioned as front-end delivery points for Government, Private and Social sector services and the idea is to develop a platform that can enable Government, Private and Social sector organizations to integrate their social and commercial goals for the benefit of rural population in the remotest corners of the country through a combination of IT as well as non IT Services. The Common Service Centre scheme is a 3 tier implementation structure with the verticals of Village Level Entrepreneur (VLE), Service Centre Agency (SCA) and State Designation Agency (SDA) as arm of the Government.

2. In G.O.Ms.No.17, IT Department dated 4.6.2007, orders have been issued that the Common Service Centre programme as per the guidelines of Government of India be adopted and implemented in Tamil Nadu. Around 5440 Common Service Centres are being set up through out the State at the rate of 1:3 for every census village. M/s 3i Infotech and SREI SAHAJ Ltd have been selected as the Service Centre Agency for implementing the Common Service Centres.

3. The Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency (TNeGA) has suggested certain names and logos for the purpose of unique identification and use in the Common Service Centers and requested the Government to choose and approve a name and logo for the centres.

4. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu e-Governance Agency and decided to approve the name of the Common Service Centres as **“People’s Computer Centre”** in English and **“மக்கள் கணினி மையம்”** in Tamil and the logo/Banner (specimen) as annexed to this order for use in the Common Service Centres.
