## **ORDER:**

The Government of India have introduced a new Additional Central Assistance scheme to incentivise States to draw up plans for their agriculture sector more comprehensively, taking agro – climatic conditions, natural resource issues and technology into account and integrating livestock, poultry and fisheries. The National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) aims at achieving 4% annual growth in agriculture sector during XIth Plan period by ensuring holistic development of Agriculture and allied sectors.

2. The Government of India have allocated an amount of Rs.185.31 crores under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) to this state and released an amount of Rs. 150.70 crores for implementation of projects under Stream-I of National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) for Agriculture and allied sectors for the year 2007-2008. This is 100% grant by the Government of India for the programme.

3. The State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) for National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) was constituted under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to sanction project proposals under Stream-I vide G.O. first read above as per the guidelines of NADP. In the above said Government Order the TAWDEVA has also been nominated as State Nodal Agency.

4. The first meeting of SLSC was held on 15.12.2007 to consider and sanction the project proposals under Stream-I as submitted by Executive Director, TAWDEVA. It includes the project proposals of Public Works Department (Irrigation) submitted at an estimate cost of Rs.12.08 crores. The project proposals relate to rehabilitation and improvements of minor water sources with focus on distribution channels with each individual work commanding only in hundreds of hectares; largely to bridge the irrigation gaps between the registered ayacut and actual cultivated area to obtain benefit-cost ratio well within the State's existing norm of 1:1 and to address very much the objective of giving enhanced return to farmers through higher production and productivity. All the eleven works proposed under minor irrigation component are located in water stress areas of drought prone districts in Tamil Nadu and these have been identified in consultation and confirmation with the District Collectors. The SLSC approved the Project subject to acceptance by the Department of Agriculture and Co-operation of the Government of India. Now, the Government of India have conveyed their approval for project proposal of Public Works Department (Irrigation).

5. The Executive Director, TAWDEVA in his letter last read above has forwarded the detailed project proposals of Public Works Department (Irrigation) at an estimated cost of Rs. 12.08 crores for approval.

6. The Government after careful examination accept and accord administrative sanction for taking up of Rehabilitation and improvement works in 11 minor water resources at an estimated cost of Rs. 12.08 crores (Rupees twelve crores and eight lakhs only) as indicated in the Annexure to this order.

7. The amount sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited under the following new head of account:-

“4702-00-Capital outlay on Minor Irrigation 101 – Surface water – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan – II. State Plan- JQ. Rehabilitation and Improvements works in minor water sources under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) Rashtriya Krishi Vikas Yojana (RKVY). 16 – Major works” (DPC 4702-00-101-JQ-1608)

8. The Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Organization and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department is the Estimating, Reconciling and Controlling Authority for the above new sub-head of account. The Pay and Accounts Office/Treasury Offices are requested to open the above new sub-head of account in their accounts.

9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of Legislature, the expenditure shall initially be met by drawal of advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which will be issued from the Finance (BG.I) Department separately. The Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Organization and Chief Engineer (General) Public Works Department is requested to send an application in the prescribed format for the sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund for the required amount to the Government in Finance (BG.I) Department together with a copy of this order. He is also requested to send necessary explanatory notes to Finance (P.W.II) Department for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Final Supplementary Estimate 2007-2008 at the appropriate time without fail.

10. The duration of implementation of project shall be one year from the date of issue of Government Order. The Rehabilitation and improvements works in 11 minor water sources shall be implemented and monitored by the Engineer-in-Chief, Water Resources Organization and Chief Engineer (General), Public Works Department, Chennai. Under no circumstances any deviation from the decisions of State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) shall be permitted.

11. TAWDEVA – the Nodal Agency, shall prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes to ensure that implementing agency adhere to them.

12. The Executive Director, TAWDEVA is requested to send the monthly progress report to Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.

13. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.71/SS(PK)/08 dated 7.3.2008 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1988 (One thousand nine hundred and eighty eight).
