### **ORDER:**

The Government of India have introduced a new Additional Central Assistance scheme to incentivise States to draw up plans for their agriculture sector more comprehensively, taking agro – climatic conditions, natural resource issues and technology into account, and integrating livestock, poultry and fisheries. The National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) aims at achieving 4% annual growth in agriculture sector during XI Plan period by ensuring holistic development of Agriculture and allied sectors.

2. The Government of India have allocated an amount of Rs. 185.31crores under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) to this state and released an amount of Rs.150.70 crores for implementation of

projects under Stream-I of National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) for Agriculture and allied sectors for the year 2007-2008.

3. The State Level Sanctioning Committee (SLSC) for National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) was constituted under the Chairmanship of Chief Secretary to sanction project proposal under Stream-I vide G.O. first read above as per the guidelines of NADP. In the above said G.O. the TAWDEVA has also been nominated as State Nodal Agency.

4. The first meeting of SLSC was held on 15.12.2007 to consider and sanction the project proposals under Stream-I in respect of Agriculture and allied sectors as submitted by Executive Director, TAWDEVA, and the committee accorded approval for the proposals of Agriculture and allied sectors with its observations. In accordance with the observations of the State Level Sanctioning Committee, the Commissioner of Animal Husbandry has submitted his detailed projects report through TAWDEVA for approval and the project proposal relates to identification and traceability of breedable bovines for monitoring at a cost of Rs.157.00 lakhs. The identification of the animal is the key for monitoring of bovine breeding activities. It has been proposed that nine lakh breedable female bovines are to be identified by ear tag with plastic (polyurethane) tags with laser printed unique numbers. Also, to provide a detail pass book with animals and owner details for the animals brought to the Artificial Insemination centres for artificial insemination and artificial insemination done by AI workers to enable unique identification and collection of data.

5. The Government, after careful examination, accord approval for the detailed project proposal of the Commissioner of Animal Husbandry for identification and traceability of breedable bovines for monitoring at a cost of Rs.157.00 lakhs and also sanction an amount of Rs.157.00 lakhs (Rupees one hundred and fifty seven lakhs only) to Commissioner of Animal Husbandry for implementation of the programme as indicated in the Annexure to this order.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above, shall be debited under the following new head of account under Demand No.6 Animal Husbandry (Animal Husbandry, Dairying and Fisheries Department):-

7. The Commissioner of Animal Husbandry is the estimating, reconciling and controlling authority for the above new sub-head of account. The Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officer concerned is requested to open the new sub-head of account in their accounts.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall constitute an item of New Instrument of Service for which the approval of the legislature will be obtained in due course. The amount will be included in the Final Supplementary Estimates 2007-08. The Commissioner of Animal Husbandry along with the copy of the order to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Final Supplementary Estimates 2007-08 at the appropriate time without fail. The expenditure shall be incurred after the presentation of the Final Supplementary Estimates 2007-08 in the Legislative Assembly.

9. The duration of the project is one year from the date of issue of G.O. The Commissioner of Animal Husbandry shall be responsible for the implementation and monitoring of the Project with the assistance of Tamil Nadu Cooperative Milk Producers' Federation Limited. Under no circumstances, any deviation from the decision of SLSC shall be permitted.

10. TAWDEVA – the Nodal Agency, shall prescribe benchmarks for outcomes, milestones with time lines and monitor the outcomes to ensure that implementing agencies adhere to them.

11. The Executive Director, TAWDEVA, is requested to send the monthly progress report to Government of India, in the prescribed format by 10<sup>th</sup> of the subsequent month under intimation to this Government without fail.

12. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.99/SS(PK)/08, dated 14.03.2008.
