ORDER:

The Director, Centre for Agriculture and Rural Development Studies, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has stated that Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has been entrusted with the preparation of District Agriculture Plans / State Agriculture Plan under National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP) and the preparation of District Agriculture Plan (DAP) for 2008-2009 is going on. The Vice Chancellor, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has informed that a Project Planning Unit for preparation of District Agriculture Plans / State Agriculture Plan has been constituted with Vice Chancellor as Chairman and the Director, Centre for Agriculture and Rural Development Studies as Member-Secretary along with Scientists concerned. The team will coordinate with Joint Directors of Agriculture and District Heads of other line departments including Animal Husbandry and Fisheries Department in the preparation of District Agriculture Plans. The Team will give the final report to Director, Centre for Agriculture and Rural Development Studies, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University. The Government of India in the sanction order dated 3.1.2008 have sanctioned and released grants-in-aid of Rs.2.90 crores at the rate of Rs.10 lakhs per district for 29 districts for preparation of District Agriculture Plan for 2007-2008. The Director, Centre for Agriculture and Rural Development Studies, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University has requested the Government to sanction the funds released by the Government of India.

2. The Government after careful examination accept the proposal of Director, Centre for Agriculture and Rural Development Studies, Tamil Nadu Agricultural University and sanction Rs.2.90 crore (Rupees two crore and ninety lakhs only) to Tamil Nadu Agricultural University as grants-in-aid under National Agriculture Development Programme for the preparation of District Agricultural Plans / State Agriculture Plan.

3. The amount sanctioned in para 2 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

Assistance to other institutions – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan - II
State Plan – JD – Grants to Tamil Nadu Agricultural University - Schemes under
National Agriculture Development Programme (NADP-RKVY) – 09 Grants-in-aid
– 03 Grants for specific schemes
(DPC 2415 -01 – 120 – JD – 0934)

4. Necessary funds have been provided in the Final Modified Appropriation 2007-2008 and the same is brought to the notice of Legislature by specific inclusion in the Final Supplementary Estimates 2007-2008.

5. The Joint Director of Agriculture, Coimbatore is authorised to draw the amount of Rs.2.90 crore (Rupees two crore and ninety lakhs only) sanctioned in para 2 above through a Crossed Cheque and disburse it to Tamil Nadu Agricultural University under due acknowledgement.

6. The Tamil Nadu Agricultural University shall deposit this amount in the accounts of the University and maintain accounts separately for the purpose for which it was sanctioned and send progress reports in the prescribed formats to the Executive Director, Tamil Nadu Watershed Development Agency under intimation to Government.
