### **Read**

From the Director of Fisheries Letter No. 30610/T1/2004, dated 22.02.2006

### **ORDER:**

In his letter cited, the Director of Fisheries has stated that there has been a persistent demand for the fishermen residing in Colachel and surrounding village to establish a Fishing Harbour and Colachel is one of the locations identified and included in the Master Plan prepared by Central Institute of Coastal Engineering for Fishery (CICEF ), Bangalore for Development of Fishing Harbour in Tamilnadu to the existing Harbour. The Director of Fisheries has initiated 8 project proposal to construct a Fishing Harbour at Colachel in Kanniyakumari District.

2. The Director, Central Institute of Coastal Engineering for Fishery, Bangalore, has finalized the cost estimates of this project for a sum of Rs. 23.50 crores and recommended to Government of India. The Director, Central Institute of Coastal Engineering for Fishery, Bangalore, has also evaluated the Techno-Economic Feasibility Report (TEFR) for the construction of the Fishing Harbour at Colachel in Kanniyakumari District. He has also indicated that the Financial Internal Rate of Return (FIRR) for this project works out to 23% to 24% and the Harbour is expected to provide employment opportunity to about 2600 persons onboard fishing vessels and about

600 persons on shore based activities and market establishments. It is expected that it will be completed within four years and the expenditure on construction for each year will be as follows:-

Ist Year Construction	-	Rs. 400.00 lakhs
IIInd Year Construction	-	Rs. 600.00 lakhs
IIIrd Year Construction	-	Rs. 800.00 lakhs
IVth Year Construction	-	Rs. 550.00 lakhs
<b>Total</b>	-	<b>Rs. 2350.00 lakhs</b>

3. The Director of Fisheries has also stated that the project on construction of Fishing Harbour at Coalchel in Kanniyakumari District will beat a total cost of Rs. 23.50 crores and is to be implemented under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme on 50:50 sharing basis between the Central Government and the Government of Tamilnadu.

4. The Director of Fisheries has also requested to sanction Rs.4.00 lakhs for payment of consent fee to the Tamilnadu Pollution Control Board (TNPCCB) and Director of Environment to obtain clearance besides sanction of Rs. 6.00 lakhs for conducting preliminary studies on soil investigation and fixing alignment of water front structure. He has also requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs. 2.00 crores as State share for implementation of construction of Fishing Harbour at Colachel during first year.

5. The Government have examined the proposal of Director of Fisheries and decided to accept it. Accordingly, the Government sanction a sum of Rs. 2.00 crores (Rupees two crores only) as State share towards the implementation of the construction of Fishing Harbour at Colachel in Kanniykumari District during first year. The Government also sanction a sum of Rs. 4.00 lakhs (Rupees four lakhs only) towards the payment of consent fee to TNPCCB and Director of Environment for obtaining Environment Clearance and Rs. 6.00 lakhs (Rupees six lakhs only) towards conducting preliminary studies for soil investigation and fixing alignment of water front structure.

6. The Expenditure sanctioned in para – 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

**“4405-00-Capital outlay on fisheries-104 Fishing Harbour and Landing facilities – Schemes the Tenth Fiver Year Plan VI Schemes shared between State and Centre – UA Development of landing facilities -16 - Major Works .

7. The expenditures of Rs. 210.00 lakhs sanctioned in para-5 above shall be on a “New service” and the approval of the legislature will be obtained in due course including to in the supplementary Estimate 2006-07. Pending approval of the Legislature, the

expenditure shall be initially met by an advance from the Contingency Fund Tamilnadu. The Special Commissioner of Fisheries is requested to apply for the advance in the prescribed format in duplicate to Finance (BG-I) Department along with the copy of the Order and also directed, to send necessary proposals to Finance Department for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2006-07.

8. The Special Commissioner of Fisheries is permitted to draw the amount sanction in para -5 above and to incur the expenditure, to implement the scheme.

9. The Special Commissioner of Fisheries, Chennai -6 is directed to take action for obtaining the Central Share of the scheme early.

10. This orders issued with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 50020/AH&F/2006, dated 01.09.2006 and Additional Sanction ledger No.477.
