ORDER

In his letter first read above the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has sent the proposal for sanction of Rs.7137.95 lakhs for the implementation of the works under Tamil Nadu Afforestation Project Phase II during 2006-07. In his letter second read above , the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has sent proposals to sanction an amount of Rs. 584.396 lakhs for the implementation of the maintenance and upkeep works under the Tamil Nadu Afforestation Project during 2006-07. In his letter third read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests sent proposal to revalidate the unspent amount of Rs.227.43 lakhs sanctioned in G.O. Ms. No. 180 Environment and Forests Department, dated. 26.9.2005, G.O. Ms. No.209 Environment and Forests Department, dated. 15.11.2005 and G.O. Ms. No.24 Environment and Forests Department, dated.28.2.2006 for carrying out the spill over works during 2006-07. The above proposals were under consideration of Government.

2. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has now stated that necessary proposals for 2007-08 works under TAP Phase II and maintenance and for revalidation of certain works to be carried out in 2006-07 at a total cost of Rs.7494.866 lakhs were sent to Government. He has also stated that the Government has allotted Rs. 8130.52 lakhs in Budget Estimate for the year 2006-07 for Tamil Nadu Afforestation Project. These proposals were placed before the High Level Empowered Committee for Tamil Nadu Afforestation

Project on 30.5.2006 and the committee has approved the proposals. Further the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests has pointed out that in order to expedite certain time bound works. i.e. maintenance of nursery, digging pits, soil and water conservation works and entry point activities in Buffer Zone, the funds are urgently required. He has therefore requested for the release of adhoc Letter of Credit to the tune of Rs.2998 lakhs, which is 40% of the total cost of Rs.7494.866 lakhs for the works to be carried out during 2006-07.

3. The Government after careful examination, accept the proposal of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and authorize the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests to draw adhoc Letter of Credit to the tune of Rs.2998.00 Lakhs (Rupees twenty nine crores and ninety eight lakhs only) which is 40% of the total cost of Rs.7494.866 lakhs for carrying out the Annual works under Tamil Nadu Afforestation Project -II, maintenance works and the spill over works under Tamil Nadu Afforestation Project Phase II during 2006-07 in anticipation of Government orders.

4. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to ensure that the inflation index/rate is maintained at 1.8% over the basic unit cost as provided in MOD.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:

“4406 Capital outlay on forestry and Wild Life – 01 Forestry 102 Social and Farm Forestry Schemes in the Eleventh Five year plan II State Plan PD – Tamil Nadu Afforestation Project (Phase II) funded by Japan Bank for International Co-operation -18 Major Works.”
