



## Abstract

Dairy Development Department – Part II Scheme for the year 2008-2009 – Provision of Automatic Milching Machine - Project cost of Rs.16.25 lakhs – Sanctioned - Orders - Issued.

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ORDER:

The Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development has stated that under the Operation Flood, Dairy Co-operative Societies were formed at Village level in Tamil Nadu and functioning well with the co-operation of milk producers, consumers and public in general. At present, many of the milk producers are switching from Dairy sector to other fields due to various reasons. One of the main reasons is non availability of labourer for milking. Due to this problem, some of the milk producers in the Dairy Co-operative Societies are supplying milk to the private vendors at lesser rate than the Government rate. The reason is the private vendors are directly milking the animals at the farmers house. Due to scarcity of labourers, the members are facing problems in the dairy industry. To avoid the above mentioned economical loss to the milk producers and to avoid milk handling, the mobile milking machines, may be provided to the Dairy Co-operative Societies so that the members pouring milk to the private vendors may supply the milk to the Dairy Co-operative Societies. The tentative cost for 5 mobile milking machines is as follows:-

Cost of one milk machine (Milching 2 animals at a time)	:	Rs.1,25,000/-
Cost of one mini door auto	:	Rs.2,00,000/-
	Total :	Rs.3,25,000/-
Cost for 5 Nos. of mobile milking machine 5 X 3.25 lakhs	:	Rs.16,25,000/-

2. Therefore the Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development has proposed to provide Automatic Milching Machine to the Co-operative Milk Producers' because it avoids direct contract between milker

and milk with this facility. The Dairy Co-operative Societies can procure more milk and clean milk. The Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development has therefore requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.16.25 lakhs (Rupees sixteen lakhs and twenty five thousand only) under Part-II Scheme for the year 2008-09.

3. After careful examination, the Government accept the proposal of the Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development and accordingly sanction a sum of Rs.16.25 lakhs (Rupees sixteen lakhs and twenty five thousand only) under Part-II Scheme for the year 2008-09 to provide of Automatic Milking Machine.

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account: -

5. The Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above to the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Co-operative Milk Producers' Federation Limited for this purpose. The Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development and the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Co-operative Milk Producers' Federation Limited are requested to follow the tender procedure laid down in the Tamil Nadu Tender Transparency Rules, 2000. They are also requested to furnish the progress report in the implementation of the project to Government every month.
