



Abstract

Dairy Development Department – Part II Scheme for the year 2008-2009 – Provision of two borewells with motors - Project cost of Rs.3.00 lakhs – Sanctioned - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

The Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development has stated that 125 acres of Usufruct Trees Orchards are maintained under Rain Fed condition. Cashewnut, Mango, Jack Fruit trees are grown without any irrigation. Now there is yield to the extent of Rs.7 to 8 lakhs per year. The yield and quality of Fruits are reducing year by year. If the orchard trees are irrigated, yield and quality of the Fruits can be increased upto the extent of Rs.2 to 3 lakhs per year. In the surrounding areas of the orchard, ground water is sold out by the land holders during the past 5 years. There by Ground water table of this orchard area reduced drastically. Hence it is very necessary to provide two nos. of borewells to irrigate the 125 acres orchard with 5000 nos. of usufruct trees and newly planted seedlings in Madhavaram Milk Colony. 120 ft. depth 9 inches diameter Borewell with 5 HP Electric Motor and small motor room are necessary with the expenditure of Rs.1.5 lakhs for each Borewell includes Electric Motor and Small motor room. Two Borewell with Electric Motor and Motor room will cost approximately Rs.3.00 lakhs.

2. Therefore the Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development has proposed for the Provision of two Borewells with electric motors for the usufruct trees orchard at a total cost of Rs.3.00 lakhs (Rupees three lakhs only). The Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development has therefore requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.3.00 lakhs (Rupees three lakhs only) under Part-II Scheme for the year 2008-09.

3. After careful examination, the Government accept the proposal of the Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development and accordingly sanction a sum of Rs.3.00 lakhs (Rupees three lakhs only) under Part-II Scheme for the year 2008-09 for provision of two bore wells with electric motors at fruit farm.

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account: -

5. The Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development is authorized to draw and incur the amount sanctioned in para 3 above and execute the work as per tender procedure. The Commissioner for Milk Production and Dairy Development is also requested to furnish the progress report in the implementation of the project to Government every month.
