#### ORDER :

Saving-cum-Relief Scheme is one of the three components of the Centrally Sponsored National Scheme, for Welfare of Fishermen. Under this component as per the guidelines of Government of India, Rs.75/- per month for 8 fishing months in a year, will be collected from the eligible marine fishermen and remitted into Government Account. At the end of the 8 months, the Collector sum of Rs.600/- will be matched with 50% Share of Rs.300/- by the State Government and 50% share of Rs.300/- by the Government of India as grants-in-aid. The aggregate sum of Rs.1200/- will be distributed to the beneficiary during the remaining 4 lean months, or non-fishing season at the rate of Rs.300/- per month. This scheme is being implemented in this State in 13 coastal districts as per the guidelines prescribed by the Government of India.

2. As per the climatic conditions three different fishing seasons or observed in this State as follows:-

3. The Government of India in the letter first read above have converged their administrative approval for continuance of this scheme for implementation during the year 2006-2007.

4. In the Government Order second read above orders have been issued for implementation of Saving-cum-Relief Scheme for marine fishermen for a sum of Rs.15,19,88,700.00 (Rupees fifteen crores nineteen lakhs eighty eight thousand and seven hundred only) being the State and Government of India share including the marine fishermen beneficiaries contributions as relief amount for disbursement to 1,27,985 marine fishermen of 10 districts for which the lean period starts from September and ends in December 2006, under the ongoing Centrally Sponsored Saving-cum-Relief Scheme for the year 2006-2007.

5. In his letter third read above the Director of Fisheries has stated that a sum of Rs.1,19,69,550/- has been collected from the 20721 marine fishermen of Thoothukudi and Tirunelveli districts during the fishing period from July 2006 to February 2007. The Director of Fisheries has therefore requested the Government for sanction of a sum of Rs.2,39,39,100/- (Rupees Two crores thirty nine lakhs thirty nine thousand and one hundred

fishermen of Thoothukudi and Tirunelveli districts, under the saving-cum-Relief Scheme for the year 2006-07 as follows:-

The Government after careful examination, sanction a sum of Rs.2,39,39,100/- (Rupees Two crores thirty nine lakhs thirty nine thousand and one hundred only) towards the disbursement to 20721 marine fishermen of Thoothukudi and Tirunelveli districts under the Saving-cum-Relief Scheme for the year 2006-07 under the scheme shared between State and Centre.

7. The amount sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:

"2405 -00-Fisheries-800 Other expenditure-Schemes in the 10<sup>th</sup> Five Year Plan -VI Schemes Shared between State and Centre - UA Relief Scheme for Tamil Nadu marine fishermen during lean months - 11 subsidies -01 Individual based subsidy.
