**ORDER:**

In the G.O first read above, the Government have sanctioned a non recurring expenditure of Rs.10.00 Lakhs under part II scheme for the year 2004 – 05 for promoting innovative Environmental Research Projects in the areas of Solid Waste Management, Lake Conservation and Bio Medical Waste Management.

2. The Director of Environment in the letter dated 24.4.2006, has stated that out of the above sanctioned amount a sum of Rs. 5.13 lakhs was released for 3 research projects and the balance amount of Rs. 4.87 lakhs was surrendered in 2004-05, Since it was not utilized As the research projects sanctioned in the said G.O. have been completed by the researchers, subsequently the balance amount has to be paid to them for completion of the project. He has therefore requested the Government to revalidate a sum of Rs.4.87 lakhs under the head of a/c '3435.03.001.JA.0934'.

3. The Government after due consideration, accept the proposal of the Director of Environment and permit to utilize the unspent amount of Rs. 4.87 lakhs(Rupees Four Lakhs and Eighty Seven thousand only) being the unspent amount sanctioned in the G.O first read above towards innovative Environmental Research Project to settle the balance amount to the Researchers, during 2007-08.

4.This expenditure shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“3435 Ecology and Environment – 03 Environmental Research and Ecological Regeneration – 001 Direction and Administration – Schemes in the Eleventh Five year plan - II State Plan JA Environment Department – 09 Grants in Aid 01- 03 Grants for specific schemes”.

5. Necessary, Funds will be provided in the RE/FMA 2007-08. Pending provision of funds, the Director of Environment is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned through the letter of credit. The Director of Environment is requested to include this amount while sending the budget proposals for RE/FMA 2007-08 to Government in Finance (AHF) Department, with out fail.
