ORDER:

In the reference first read above, the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden for seeking Central Assistance of Rs.24.60 lakhs for taking up certain works for development of Guindy National Park along with other Sanctuaries and National Parks was forwarded to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests for approval and release of funds as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 2007-2008.

2. The Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests in their letter second read above have conveyed their administrative approval for a sum of Rs.23.60 lakhs and released Rs.,16.52 lakhs as first installment for the development of Guindy National Park during 2007-2008.

3. The Government accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.23.60 lakhs (Rupees Twenty Three lakhs and Sixty thousands only) and release a sum of Rs.16.52 lakhs (Rupees Sixteen lakhs and Fifty-two thousands only) as first installment towards the expenditure on the items of works as detailed in the Annexure to this order for the development of Guindy National Park during 2007-2008. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests shall ensure that the expenditure in this regard does not exceed the sanction amount and to send the Utilization Certificate to Government of India in time.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account :

“4406 Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wildlife 02 Environmental Forestry and Wildlife -111 Zoological Park – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year plan-III Centrally Sponsored SB Development of Guindy National Park – 16 Major Works (DPC 4406 02 111 SB 1602)”.

5. Necessary funds will be provided in the Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2007-08 and pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to include this amount while sending the Budget Proposal for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2007-2008 to Government without fail.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.55041/AHF/2007, dated 22.8.07 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.785 (Seven hundred and eighty-five).
