ORDER:

In the reference first read above, the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden seeking Central Assistance of Rs.21.78 lakhs for taking up certain works for development of Karaivetti Bird Sanctuary was forwarded to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests for approval and release of funds as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 2007-2008.

2. The Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests in their letter second read above have conveyed their administrative approval for a sum of Rs.5.63 lakhs and released Rs.4.00 lakhs as first installment for the development of Karaivetti Bird Sanctuary during 2007-2008.

3. The Government therefore accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.5.63 lakhs (Rupees Five lakhs and sixty-three thousands only) and release a sum of Rs.4.00 lakhs (Rupees Four lakhs only) towards the expenditure on the items of works as detailed in the Annexure to this order for the development of Karaivetti Bird Sanctuary during 2007-2008.

4. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests shall ensure that the expenditure in this regard does not exceed the sanction amount and to send the Utilization Certificate to Government of India in time.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“4406 Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wildlife - 02 Environmental Forestry and Wildlife – 110 Wildlife Preservation Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan-III Centrally Sponsored - SS Eco-Development of Karaivetti Birds Sanctuary - 16 Major Works (DPC 4406 02 110 SS 1600)”.

6. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure through the Letter of Credit.
