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ORDER:

In the reference second read above, the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden for seeking Central Assistance of Rs.135.00 lakhs for taking up certain works for implementation of Management Action Plan Development of Mangroves in Pitchavaram was forwarded to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests for approval and release of funds as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 2007-2008.

2. The Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests in their letter third read above have conveyed their approval for sanction and release of balance amount of Rs.6.10 lakhs towards completing the unfinished tasks under the Management Action Plan sanctioned for the year 2006-2007 for conservation and Management Action Plan for Development of Mangroves in Pitchavaram during the year 2007-2008.

3. The Government accordingly sanction and release a sum of Rs. 6.10 lakhs (Rupees Six lakhs and ten thousands only) as the balance amount for completing the unfinished tasks under the Management Action Plan sanctioned in the G.O. first read above for the year 2006-2007 for conservation and Management Action Plan for Development of Mangroves in Pitchavaram during 2007-2008.

4. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests shall ensure that the expenditure in this regard does not exceed the sanction amount and to send the Utilization Certificate to Government of India in time. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests should adhere to the conditions stipulated in the letter fourth read above. /9

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

“4406 Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wildlife 02 Environmental Forestry and Wildlife – 110 Wildlife Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan-III Centrally Sponsored SE Conservation and Management of Mangroves 16 Major Works (DPC 4406 02 110 SE 1608)”.
