ORDER:

In the reference first read above, the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden for seeking Central Assistance of Rs.16.00 lakhs for taking up certain works for development of Vedanthangal Bird Sanctuary was forwarded to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests for approval and release of funds as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 2007-2008.

2. The Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests in their letter second read above have conveyed their administrative approval for a sum of Rs.11.90 lakhs and released Rs.8.00 lakhs as first installment for the development of Vedanthangal Bird Sanctuary during 2007-2008.

3. The Government therefore accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs.11.90 lakhs (Rupees Eleven lakhs and ninety thousands only) and release a sum of Rs.8.00 lakhs (Rupees Eight lakhs only) as first installment towards the expenditure on the items of works as detailed in the Annexure to this order for the development of Vedanthangal Bird Sanctuary during 2007-2008.

4. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests shall ensure that the expenditure in this regard does not exceed the sanction amount and to send the Utilization Certificate to Government of India in time.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

“4406 Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wildlife 02 Environmental Forestry and Wildlife – 110 Wildlife - Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan-III Centrally Sponsored SB Scheme for Development of Vedanthangal Birds Sanctuary - 16 Major Works (DPC 4406 02 110 SB 1604)”.

6. Necessary funds will be provided in Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation for 2007-2008 and pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned through the Letter of Credit. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to include this amount while sending the Budget proposals for Revised Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation for 2007-2008 to Government in Finance (AHF) Department without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.57590/AHF/07, dated 6.9.2007 Additional Sanction Ledger No.874 (Eight hundred and seventy four).
