### ORDER:

In the reference first read above, the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden for seeking Central Assistance of Rs.76.92 lakhs for taking up certain works for development of Gulf of Mannar Marine National park was forwarded to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests for approval and release of funds as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 2007-2008.

2. The Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests in their letter second read above have conveyed their administrative approval for a sum of Rs.21.20 lakhs and released for a sum of Rs.16.00 lakhs as first installment for the development of Gulf of Mannar Marine National park during 2007-2008. Further the Government of India have adjusted Rs.1.33 lakhs towards unspent balance amount available with the State Government.

3. The Government therefore accord administrative sanction for a sum of Rs. 21.20 lakhs ( Rupees Twenty One Lakhs and twenty thousand only) and release a sum of Rs.17.33 lakhs (Rupees Seventeen lakhs and thirty three thousands only) (i.e. Rs.16.00 lakhs as first installment + 1.33 lakhs of unspent amount ) towards the expenditure on the items of works as detailed in the Annexure to this order for the development of Gulf of Mannar Marine National park during 2007-2008.

4. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests shall ensure that the expenditure in this regard does not exceed the sanction amount and to send the Utilization Certificate to Government of India in time.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“4406 Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wildlife 01 Forestry – 101 Forest Conservation Development and Regeneration – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan-III Centrally Sponsored - SA Scheme of establishment of Gulf of Mannar Biosphere Reserve -16 Major Works (DPC 4406 01 101 SA 1606)”.
