ORDER:

The Government of India in their letter first read above released an amount of Rs.13.25 lakhs as final instalment for the implementation of the balance work of the year 2004-2005 relating to the Management Action Plan for the Nilgiris Bio Sphere Reserve after adjusting an unspent amount of Rs.25,000/- of the year 2004-2005 during the year 2005-2006. As the said sanction of Government of India was received at the end of March, 2006, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden in his letter second read above requested the Government of India to revalidate the amount sanctioned for utilization during the year 2006-2007.

2. The Government of India in their letter third read above has revalidated the amount of Rs.13.25 lakhs which was released in their letter second read above, as final instalment to complete the works under the Management Action Plan for the Nilgiris Bio Sphere Reserve during 2005-2006 for utilization during the year 2006-2007 subject to the terms and conditions already detailed in their letter first read above.

3. In the G.O. fifth read above, the Government accorded sanction an amount of Rs.13.25 lakhs (Rupees Thirteen lakhs and twenty five thousand only) as the final instalment to complete spillover works under the Management Action Plan for the Nilgiris Bio Sphere Reserve of the year 2004-2005 which were carried forward to the year 2005-2006 and subsequently to the year 2006-07 subject to the terms and conditions already laid down by the Government of India in their letter first read above during the year 2007-08.

4. In the reference fifth read above, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden has requested the Government of Tamil Nadu to issue orders for sanction and release of Rs.13.50 lakhs. But the Government have sanctioned Rs.13.25 lakhs only leaving unspent balance of Rs.0.25 lakhs. He has therefore requested that necessary sanction for release of unspent balance amount of Rs.0.25 lakhs so as to complete the works taken up under the said scheme.

5. The Government after careful consideration, release the unspent amount of Rs.0.25 lakhs (Rupees Twenty Five Thousands Only) relating to the year 2005-06 to complete spill over works under Management Action Plan for Nilgiris Biosphere Reserve during 2007-08 subject to the terms and conditions already laid down by the Government of India in their letter first read above.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account :-

“4551 Capital Outlay on Hill Areas 60 Other Hill Areas - 106 Forestry and Wildlife – Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan – III – Centrally Sponsored SA – Action Plan for Nilgiris Biosphere Reserve 16 Major works (DPC 4551-60-106-SA-1609)”.

7. Necessary funds will be provided in the Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2007-08 and pending provision of such funds, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to include this amount while sending the Budget proposals for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2007-08 to Government in Finance (AHF) Department without fail.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.75614/AH&F/07, dated 22.11.2007 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1341 (One thousand three hundred and forty one).
