ORDER

In the order first read above, the Government have simplified the procedure of sanction/revalidation of Centrally Sponsored Schemes/Shared Schemes. A Standing Committee under the Chairmanship of the Secretary to Government, Finance Department was also constituted for the approval of the release of 25% of the expenditure immediately after the Vote on Account and Appropriation Act are passed in the Legislature and that the concerned administrative Department in the Secretariat will issue a consolidated order for all the schemes relating to that Department based on the minutes of the Standing Committee.

2. The above Standing Committee in its meeting held on 26.9.2006 has approved among other things, the release of Rs.3.50 lakhs for 2006-2007 in respect of the development of Kanjirakulam Bird Sanctuary.

3. The Government of India in their letter fourth read above have conveyed their approval for revalidating the unspent amount of Rs.3.50 lakhs for the year 2005-06 for utilizing the current financial year 2006-07 for the development of Kanjirakulam Bird Sanctuary.

4. The Government after careful examination accord sanction for release of Rs.3.50 lakhs (Rupees three lakhs and fifty thousand only) for the development of Kanjirakulam Bird Sanctuary for the year 2006-07.

5. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to ensure that the expenditure now sanctioned in para 4 above is incurred only for the purpose for which the proposals were sent to the Government of India.

6. The amount sanctioned now in para 4 above shall be debited to the following new sub head of account under Demand No.15, Environment and Forests Department as detailed below :-

4406-Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wildlife -02. Environmental Forestry and Wildlife – 110. Wildlife Schemes in the Tenth Five Year Plan- III Centrally Sponsored – SC Scheme for Development of Kanjirakulam Bird Sanctuary – 16. Major Works. (D.P.Code 4406 02 111 SC 1600)

7. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests will be the estimating, reconciling and controlling authority of the above new sub head of account. The Pay and Accounts Officer/Treasury Officer concerned is requested to open the above new sub head of account in their accounts.

8. Necessary funds will be provided in Final Modified Appropriation/Final Supplementary Estimate 2006-2007 Pending provision of funds in Final Modified Appropriation/Final Supplementary Estimate 2006-2007. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure through Letter of Credit.

9. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to include this amount while sending proposals for Final Modified Appropriation proposal 2006-2007 to Government in Finance (AH&F) Department without fail.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.8976/AH&F/07, dated 19.2.2007 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1620 (One thousand six hundred and twenty)
