ORDER:-

The Project proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests for providing infrastructural facilities in the Educational Institution run by the Forest Department in the Tribal areas, at a cost of Rs. 481.63 lakhs with his letter first read above, was forwarded to the NABARD for its assistance in the Government letter second read above.

2. The General Manager, NABARD in the letter third read above conveyed the approval of the NABARD for the Project for Providing Infrastructural facilities in the Educational Institutions of the Forest Department in Tribal areas at a cost of Rs. 507.05 lakhs. Out of which 431.00 lakh will be loan assistance under RIDF XII and the State Government contribution will be Rs. 76.05 lakhs.

3. The Government in the letter fourth read above have conveyed their acceptance for the terms and conditions to NABARD.

4. The Government, after careful consideration, accord administrative sanction for the project for providing infrastructural facilities to the Education Institutions of the Forest Department in Tribal Areas and also sanction of sum of Rs. 507.05 lakhs (Rupees Five hundred and seven lakhs and five thousands only) over a period of 3 years commencing from 2007-08 as detailed in the annexure to this order with loan assistance from NABARD under RIDF XII.

5. The total outlay of Rs. 507.05 lakhs will consist of the loan of Rs. 431.00 lakhs (Rupees four hundred and thirty one lakhs only) from NABARD under RIDF XII and State Government contribution of Rs. 76.05 lakhs (Rupees Seventy six lakhs and five thousand only)

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the new head of account to be opened under Demand No 15 Environment and Forests Department.

“ 4406 Capital outlay on forestry and wildlife 01 Forestry-796 Tribal Area Sub-Plan-Schemes in the Eleventh five plan-II State Plan JF. Providing infrastructural facilities in Educational Institutions of the Forest Department 16, Major works (DPC 4406.01-796JF1604)”

7. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is the Estimating Reconciling and Controlling authority for the above new head of account. The Pay and Accounts Officers / Treasury Officers are to open the above new head of account in their accounts.

8. The expenditure sanctioned on para 4 above is an item of “ New Service” . The approval of the Legislative will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met from the Contingency Fund, and orders regarding it will be issued by the Government in Finance (BG.I) Department. The Principal Chief conservator of Forests is requested to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG.I) Department, in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance required from contingency Fund.

9. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is also requested to send draft explanatory note, indicating the total cost of the scheme, the cost that would be required for the implementation during the financial year etc., to Government in Finance (BG.I) Department for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary estimates for bringing it to the notice of the Legislature in due course.

10. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Chennai 15 is authorized to execute the works sanctioned in para 4 above, utilizing the provisions made by NABARD and by the Government as its shares in full and to incur expenditure under the head of account as specified in para 4 above and to complete the works within the time limit prescribed by NABARD. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is also to ensure the Quality of Works as per the standards by issuing detailed instructions to the field officers. He is also requested to monitor closely and take up follow up action with

regard to the quality and timely completion of work as per the standards. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is also directed to ensure that the above works are not included/undertaken in any of the other schemes before finalizing the tenders.

11. This order issues with the concurrences of Finance Department vide its U.O.70/Ds(RC) 2007 dated 29.5.2007 and ASL.No. 179 (One hundred and seventy nine)
