**ORDER:**

In the reference first read above, the proposal of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Chief Wildlife Warden seeking Central Assistance of Rs.9.47 lakhs for taking up certain works for development of Mudumalai National Park, Udhagamandalam, The Nilgiris District was forwarded to the Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests for approval and release of funds as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme during 2006-2007.

2. The Government of India, Ministry of Environment and Forests in their letter second read above have conveyed their administrative approval for a sum of Rs.13.72 lakhs and released Rs.6.50 lakhs as first instalment for the development of Mudumalai National Park, Udhagamandalam, The Nilgiris District during 2006.2007. Further the Government of India have adjusted Rs.4.50 lakhs towards unspent amount relating to 2005-06 from the total amount of sanction.

3. The Government accordingly sanction administrative approval for a sum of Rs.13.72 lakhs (Rupees Thirteen lakhs and Seventytwo thousands only) and release a sum of Rs.11.00 lakhs (Rupees Eleven lakhs only) i.e., (Rs.6.50 lakhs towards first installment + Rs.4.50 lakhs of unspent amount) towards the expenditure on the items of works as detailed in the Annexure to this order for the development of Mudumalai National Park, Udhagamandalam, The Nilgiris District during 2006-2007.

4. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests shall ensure that the expenditure in this regard does not exceed the sanctioned amount and to send the Utilization Certificate to Government of India in time.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to the head of account:-

“4406 Capital Outlay on Forestry and Wildlife 02 Environmental Forestry and Wildlife – 110 Wildlife Schemes in the Tenth Five Year Plan-III Centrally Sponsored SJ Scheme for Development of Mudumalai National Park - 16 Major Works (DPC 4406 02 110 SJ 1608).

6. Necessary additional funds will be provided in Final Supplementary Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation for 2006-2007.

7. Pending provision of funds in Final Supplementary Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation 2006-2007. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is authorized to incur the expenditure through the Letter of Credit. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests is requested to include this amount while sending the Budget proposals for Final Supplementary Estimate/Final Modified Appropriation for 2006-2007 to Government in Finance (AHF) Department without fail.
