ORDER:-

In the letter first read above, NABARD has sanctioned a loan of Rs.757.88 Lakhs under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund IX for System Improvement in Power Sector in Tamil Nadu.

2. In the G.O. second read above, the Government released a sum of Rs.558.163 lakhs towards 20% start up advance and towards reimbursement claims sent to NABARD for Power System Improvement in Sub-transmission and distribution net work in Rural Districts viz., Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari Electricity Distribution Circles.

3. In the G.O. third read above, the Government released a sum of Rs.10.913 lakhs towards reimbursement claims sent to NABARD for Power System improvement in Sub-transmission and distribution net work in Rural Districts viz., Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari Electricity Distribution Circles.

4. In the G.O. fourth read above, Government released a sum of Rs.145.896 lakhs towards reimbursement claims sent to NABARD for Power System Improvement in Sub-transmission and distribution net work in Rural Districts viz., Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari Electricity Distribution Circles.

5. In the G.O. fifth read above, Government released a sum of Rs.93.931 lakhs towards reimbursement claims sent to NABARD for Power System Improvement in Sub-transmission and distribution net work in Rural Districts viz., Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari Electricity Distribution Circles.

6. In the G.O. sixth read above, Government released a sum of Rs.50.280 lakhs towards reimbursement claims sent to NABARD for Power System Improvement in Sub-transmission and distribution net work in Rural Districts viz., Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari Electricity Distribution Circles.

7. The Member (Accounts) / Tamil Nadu Electricity Board in the letter seventh read above has sent proposals and requested for release of Rs.8.084 lakhs towards claims filed in respect of Tirunelveli and Kanyakumari Electricity Distribution Circles, under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund-IX.

The Government after careful examination sanction and release a sum of Rs. 8,08,400/- (Rupees eight lakhs eight thousand and four hundred only) as loan to the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board out of the loan assistance of Rs.757.88 Lakhs from NABARD with the terms and conditions as stipulated in the sanction order of the NABARD in its letter first read above and as indicated in the Annexure to this order.

9. The loan sanctioned in Paragraph 8 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“6801.00 Loans for Power Project – 800, Other Loans to Electricity Boards – I Non- Plan –AE. Loans to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board for implementation of System Improvement in Power Sector with loan assistance from NABARD under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund 01 – Loans to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board.

10. The interest on the above loan shall be credited to the following head of account:-

11.The loan amount of Rs.8.084 lakhs sanctioned at para 8 above, shall be adjusted against the interest amount due from the Tamil Nadu Electricity Board

to the State Government for various schemes, such as, APDRP, PMGY etc and shall not be paid in cash, but credited to the following head of account:-

“0049 – Interest Receipts –04 Interest Receipts of State/ Union Territory Governments – 190 Interest from Public Sector and, Other Undertakings – AC –Loans to Tamil Nadu Electricity Board In cash”.

(DPC-0049 –04 –190 –AC –0006), by means of a cheque drawn in favour of “ PD Account of Tamil Nadu Electricity Board”.

12. The Chief Electrical Inspector to Government is authorized to draw the cheque for the amount sanctioned in para-8 above for making adjustment as indicated in para-11 above and to watch the recovery of Principal and Interest as per the terms and conditions of NABARD and as indicated in the Annexure to this order.
