**ORDER:**

In the Government order fourth read above, it has been ordered among other things that the employees of the organizations which are willing to bear the employers' share of the premium and are willing to collect the employees' contribution and where there is no financial liability befalling on the State Budget may be included under the coverage of the New Health Insurance Scheme. Accordingly, it has been ordered that the administrative departments in Secretariat shall arrange to expedite the willingness of the organizations under their administrative control which have been registered under the Tamil Nadu Registration of Societies Act, 1975. The Chief Executive Officers of such institutions have been directed to send necessary proposals for extension of the coverage of the New Health Insurance Scheme to their employees, if the employees are willing and if the organizations are willing to contribute the employers' share as per the provisions of the scheme.

2.In the letter fifth read above, the Director, Tamil Nadu Institute of Labour Studies, Chennai, has requested to extend the New Health Insurance Scheme to the employees of its Organisation. He has stated that the employees are willing to contribute the total annual premium alongwith service tax i.e. both the employer and employee contributions and follow the terms and conditions of the scheme.

3. In the letter sixth read above the Director, Tamil Nadu Institute of Labour Studies, was requested to intimate his willingness as to whether the entire amount of annual premium will be remitted into Government Account in respect of the employees

of the institution in advance, as per the terms and conditions of the New Health Insurance Scheme (i.e.) within one month from the date of issue of orders on extension of New Health Insurance Scheme for the first year on a prorata basis and by July 11<sup>th</sup> of every ensuing year for 3 years upto 2011 as the scheme period is upto 10.6.2012.

4. In the letter seventh read above, the Director, Tamil Nadu Institute of Labour Studies has informed willingness of the Tamil Nadu Institute of Labour Studies to remit the entire amount of annual premium into Government Account.

5. It is hereby ordered that 31 employees of the Tamil Nadu Institute of Labour Studies be covered under the New Health Insurance Scheme with immediate effect. The Director, Tamil Nadu Institute of Labour Studies, shall arrange to upload the details of the employees covered under the scheme on the website of the Treasuries and Accounts Department viz., <http://www.tn.gov.in/Karuvooram> immediately.

6. The New Health Insurance Scheme has been commenced from 11.6.2008 and the period of the scheme ends on 10.6.2012. As per the orders issued in para 4 of the Government order second read above the total annual premium for the current year has to be paid in advance by 1.12.2008 on pro-rata basis i.e. for the period from 1.11.2008 to 10.6.2009. For the ensuing years the premium has to be paid within one month of commencement of that particular year under the scheme (i.e.) before 11<sup>th</sup> of July to the following sub head of account.

7. The Director of Treasuries and Accounts shall reckon the employees covered under this Government Order also while sending proposals based on the number of Identity Cards for sanction of release of premium amounts due to the insurance company from time to time.
