



New Health Insurance Scheme – Deletion of hospitals already accredited under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme from providing coverage as Network Hospitals under the New Health Insurance Scheme - Orders – Issued.

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ORDER:

As per rule 6 (iii) of the New Health Insurance Scheme Rules 2007, all the hospitals accredited under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme shall automatically be deemed to be networked Hospitals and the Insurance Company shall ensure that they have a tie up with these hospitals.

2. In the Government Orders first, fourth, fifth and eighth read above orders have been issued networking hospitals under the New Health Insurance Scheme. In the Government letter third read above, hospitals already accredited under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme and not networked under the New Health Insurance Scheme, were addressed for expressing their willingness or otherwise for providing coverage under the New Health Insurance Scheme, based on the letter dated 10.7.2008 of M/s STAR Health and Allied Insurance Company Limited, informing that the hospitals are either not interested or closed or not having adequate infrastructure.

3. In its letter dated: 21.4.2010 M/s STAR Health and Allied Insurance Company Limited, have stated that the hospitals which were accredited under the Tamil Nadu Government Employees Health Fund Scheme, now not willing to be covered under the New Health Insurance Scheme/ not responded to their letters, though sufficient time was given for their response, need not be included in the list of network hospitals under the New Health Insurance Scheme.

4. Further in their letter dated 22.4.2010, M/s STAR Health and Allied Insurance Company Limited have reported that Krishna Hospital, Cuddalore, has also expressed their inability to continue under the New Health Insurance Scheme and requested to delete from providing coverage under the New Health Insurance Scheme.

5. It is hereby ordered that the following hospitals be deleted from the list of network hospitals appended as Annexure II to the New Health Insurance Scheme Rules 2007 of Tender Document No. 6023 / Finance/2007 to be covered under the New Health Insurance Scheme.
