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### **ORDER:**

In the Government order 4<sup>th</sup> read above, orders were issued revising the stipend being paid to the Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRI) and Non Service Post Graduate / Higher Speciality students with effect from 01.07.2009 as follows:-

It has also been ordered to provide an automatic increase of Rs.300/- per month per Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRRI) candidate and Rs.600/- per month per Post Graduate / Higher Speciality student every year.

2. The Tamil Nadu Medical Post Graduate Students and Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees (CRRRI) students Association in the representation fifth read above, have now requested the Government among others to enhance the stipend further as ordered in the Government Order fourth read above.

3. The Government, after careful consideration, direct that the rate of stipend ordered in the Government Order fourth read above be increased further for the Compulsory Rotatory Residential Internees(CRRRI), Non Service Post Graduate / Higher Speciality students as indicated below with effect from 01.07.2009:-
