### **ORDER:**

In G.O.Ms.No.342, Health and Family Welfare Department dated.17.9.2007, orders were issued for the implementation of Young Children Heart Surgery Scheme in partnership with Private Hospitals and under the Scheme, poor children with less than 12 years and who are residents of Tamil Nadu and whose parental income is less than Rs.50,000/- per year can undergo heart surgery in the Private Hospitals for which the financial assistance under Tamil Nadu State Illness Assistance Society Fund is sanctioned to the Private Hospitals in Tamil Nadu as indicated below:

1.	Closed Heart Surgeries	Rs.10,000/-
2.	Major Open Heart Surgeries / Major Heart Surgeries	Rs.30,000/-
3.	Complex Open Heart Surgeries	Rs.70,000/-

Appropriate Memorandum of Understanding was executed by the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services with 17 Private Hospitals as per G.O.Ms.No.416, Health and Family Welfare Department dated.30.10.2007. Funds are released to the Private Hospitals from the Tamil Nadu State Illness Society funds. Surgery is done to those young school children identified in the Special Camps conducted during June 2008 in the 17 Accredited Private Hospitals by utilizing the National Rural Health Mission Funds.

2. During the review meeting conducted on the performance under the scheme, it was informed that due to increase of cost of consumables in the past one year, Private Hospitals have requested the enhancement of the financial assistance. Accordingly, the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services has suggested the revision of the cost of surgery as indicated below:

The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, Chennai, has requested the Government to issue appropriate orders for enhancing the financial assistance to be paid to the accredited private Hospitals. The Chairman, K.G. Hospitals, Coimbatore has also requested the Government for the enhancement of the Grant now given under the scheme.

3. The Government have examined the request of the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services and decided to accept it. Accordingly the Government direct that the financial assistance for Young Children heart surgeries including school children heart surgeries in the accredited Private Hospitals be enhanced as indicated below:
