ORDER:

In the Budget Speech 2007-2008, the Hon'ble Minister for Finance announced that additional buildings will be constructed for Institute of Child Health attached to Madras Medical College at an estimated cost of Rs. 14 crores.

2. Accordingly the Director of Medical Education has sent proposals to Government for sanction of a sum of Rs. 14 Crores for construction of 300 bedded hospital, Out Patient Block and Casualty Building for the Institute of Child Health and Hospital for Children, Chennai containing ground floor + eight floors (9 floors) with a total built up area 9117.20Sq.m. (Total Built up floor area 8920.20 Sq.m).

3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education above and have decided to provide 1 % of the cost of work towards petty supervision and contingencies and accordingly exclude a sum of Rs.17,00,000/- (Rupees seventeen lakhs only) provided in the estimate towards petty supervision and contingencies and to sanction the balance amount. Accordingly, Administrative and Financial sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs. 13,83,00,000 /- (Rupees thirteen crores and eighty three lakhs only) for the construction of 300 bedded hospital, Out Patient Block and Casualty Building for Institute of Child Health and Hospital for Children, Chennai, containing 9 floors (Ground floor + 8 floors).

4. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph 3 above shall be debited to the following head of account under Demand No.39.

“4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services – 110 Hospital and Dispensaries (including Pharmacy) – II – State Plan – JA Buildings –16 Major works”
(D.P. Code 4210– 01–110 – JA – 1602)”

Initially a sum of Rs. 4.80 crores (Rupees four crores and eighty lakhs only) have been provided in the Budget Estimate 2007-2008 in the above mentioned head of account.

5. The Director of Medical Education / The Chief Engineer (Buildings) Public Works Department is directed to send detailed plan and estimate for approval of the Government.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O .No.70058/Fin(Health –II)/07 dated 25.10.07.
