ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above the administrative control of the Government Pentland Hospital (Urban Health Centre) was transferred to the Dean, Government Vellore Medical College.

2. In the Budget Session 2006-07 the Hon'ble Chief Minister assured for the revival of Pentland Hospital, Vellore.

3. Accordingly, the Director of Medical Education has sent proposals for creation of 265 posts of various categories, purchase of machinery, equipments, ambulance etc. to revive the Pentland Hospital, Vellore as a full fledged 100-bedded hospital at a cost of Rs. 10,50,45,000/-.

4. The Government examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in para 3 above in detail and have decided to create less number of posts and to purchase equipments for basic inpatient care and surgical management at the level of a Taluk Hospital. Accordingly they accord Administrative / Financial sanction for a sum of Rs. 2,36,47,255 (Rupees two crores thirty six lakhs forty seven thousand two hundred and fifty five only) (Recurring Rs. 1,26,47,255 + Nonrecurring Rs. 1,10,00,000) for the revival of the Pentland Hospital, Vellore as detailed below :-

5. As per the decision in para 4 above sanction is accorded for creation of 81 posts as detailed in the Annexure to this order for a period of one year from the date of employment or till the necessity ceases, whichever is earlier for the Government Pentland Hospital Vellore. The holders of the posts are eligible to draw Pay, Dearness Pay, Dearness Allowance and Other allowances at the rates admissible under the orders in force. Four posts for Assistant Surgeons (General) mentioned against serial number 2 in the Annexure shall lapse once the services of House surgeons from Vellore Medical College become available.

6. The expenditure towards payment of salary to staff shall be debited to the following head of account: -

9. The expenditure towards purchase of Ambulance shall be debited to the following head of account:-

10. The expenditure towards purchase of machinery and equipments (including Rs. 10 lakhs for Blood Bank & Laboratory equipments) shall be debited to the following head of account: -

11. The Government direct that machinery and equipments should be purchased only through the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited, Chennai and the amount should not be paid in cash but credited into the following head of account:-

“K Deposit and Advances (b) Deposits not bearing interest – 8443 00 Civil Deposits 800 Other Deposits CE Deposits of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited “.

(DPC 8443 00 800 CE 00 OH – Receipt)

by means of a cheque in favour of PD Account of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited, Chennai -8.

12. The Government further direct the Director of Medical Education

- a) to meet the maintenance works and electrical works of the Government Pentland Hospital from the regular budgetary allotment under the Directorate of Medical Education.
- b) to purchase the drugs from the regular Budget allotments of the Directorate of Medical Education.
- c) to meet the electricity, telephone charges and other contingencies from the budgetary allotment of the Vellore Medical College.

13. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service” and approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the legislature, an advance from the contingency fund shall be made to meet the expenditure initially and orders in this regard will be issued by the Finance (BGI) Department based on the application from the Director of Medical Education, Chennai in the prescribed form along with a copy of this order.

14. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.73495/Health II/ 07 dated 16.11.07 Finance (CMPC) vide U.O. No. 75914/CMPC/07 dated 19.11.2007 and Additional Sanction Ledger No. 1316 (One thousand three hundred and sixteen).
