ORDER:

The Government of India have formulated a new integrated and comprehensive scheme for the development and promotion of handlooms, namely "Deendayal Hathkargha Protsahan Yojana Scheme" with effect from 1.4.2000. The various components of the scheme are Basic Inputs, Infrastructure Support, Design Input, Publicity, Marketing Incentive/Rebate and Strengthening of Handloom Organisations.

2. The Government of India in their letter first read above, have conveyed their sanction for a sum of Rs.4,75,17,800/- as grant for implementation of projects by 290 Weavers Co-operative Societies in various circles of the State under Deendayal Hathkargha Protsahan Yojana Scheme for the year 2004-2005 and released a sum of Rs.2,35,30,000/- towards first instalment of grant component for implementation of the scheme.

3. Accordingly, in the Government order second read above, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.4,01,14,500/-

(Government of India share of Rs.2,35,30,000/- + State Government share of Rs.1,65,84,500/-) towards first instalment of grant component for implementation of projects by 290 Weavers Co-operative Societies under Deendayal Hathkargha Protsahan Yojana Scheme for the year 2004-2005.

4) Now, the Government of India in their letter third read above, have released a sum of Rs.38,78,500/- towards final instalment of Central Share of grant component for implementation of projects by 43 Weavers Co-operative Societies in various circles of the State under Deendayal Hathkargha Protsahan Yojana Scheme for the year 2004-2005.

5) The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles in his letter fourth read above, has requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.38,78,500/- released by Government of India together with the State Government share of grant of Rs.26,24,000/- aggregating to the tune of Rs.65,02,500/- towards final instalment of grant component for implementation of projects by 43 Weavers Co-operative Societies in various circles of the State under Deendayal Hathkargha Protsahan Yojana Scheme for the year 2004-2005.

6) The Government, after careful consideration, have decided to accept the request of the Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles. Accordingly, the Government sanction a sum of Rs.65,02,500/- (Rupees Sixty five lakhs two thousand and five hundred only) (Government of India's Share Rs.38,78,500/- + State Government's share Rs.26,24,000/-) towards final instalment of grant component for implementation of projects by 43 Weavers Co-operative Societies in various circles of the State under Deendayal Hathkargha Protsahan Yojana Scheme for the year 2004-2005 as indicated below:

7. (i) The expenditure of Rs.47,24,500/- (Rupees Forty seven lakhs twenty four thousand and five hundred only) sanctioned for Basic Inputs in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“2851.00 Village and Small Industries -103. Handloom Industries - VI Schemes shared between State and Centre - UI Deendayal Hathkargha Protsahan Yojana Scheme - Basic Inputs - 09. Grants-in-aid - 03. Grants for specific schemes”.

(ii) The expenditure of Rs.2,75,000/- (Rupees Two lakh and seventy five thousand only) sanctioned for Infrastructure Support in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“ 2851.00 Village and Small Industries - 103. Handloom Industries VI Schemes shared between State and Centre - UJ Deendayal Hathkargha Protsahan Yojana Scheme- Infrastructure Support -09.Grants-in-aid - 03. Grants for specific schemes”

(iii) The expenditure of Rs.15,03,000/- (Rupees Fifteen lakhs and three thousand only) sanctioned for Publicities in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“ 2851.00 Village and Small Industries -103. Handloom Industries - VI Schemes shared between State and Centre - UL Deendayal Hathkargha Protsahan Yojana Scheme - Publicities -09. Grants-in-aid - 03. Grants for specific schemes”.

8) The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 6 above to the District Officers concerned.

9) The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles is directed to follow the guidelines prescribed by the Government of India while releasing the funds to the concerned circles. He is also directed to instruct the beneficiary societies under this scheme to get a bond to this effect from the members for the common good of the societies.

10. The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles is also directed to furnish the Utilization Certificate and audited statements of expenditure to the Development Commissioner for Handlooms, New Delhi, at the earliest.
