### ORDER:-

The Tamil Nadu Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme was introduced in 1975 by the Government of Tamil Nadu for the benefit of Handloom Weavers enrolled in the Primary Weavers Cooperative Societies. The members admitted under this Scheme contribute 8 paise (Eight paise) per rupee of wages earned by them and the State Government is contributing 4 paise per rupee

of wages earned by each weaver. The Government of India contributes 4 paise per rupee of wages earned by each weaver as matching contribution under the Central Thrift Fund Scheme. The above contributions are deposited in the Government Account, on which the Government of Tamil Nadu allows 9.5% interest. Out of the 9.5% interest, 6.5% interest is credited to the Weaver Members Account and 3% interest is utilized for implementation of Old Age Pension Scheme, Family Pension Scheme and Health Package Scheme for Handloom Weavers.

2. In the Government orders first to eighteenth read above the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.26,24,14,365/- from out of interest accrued on the deposits made in the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme Fund for meeting out the expenditure under the Old Age Pension Scheme, Family Pension Scheme for Handloom Weavers.

3. The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles in his letters Nineteenth read above, has stated that interest accrued to the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme Fund as on date has been calculated as Rs.40,41,72,257/- and so far a sum of Rs.26,24,14,365/- was sanctioned on the deposits of the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme Fund for meeting out the expenditure towards Old Age Pension Scheme, Family Pension Scheme for Handloom Weavers. The balance amount available in the Account is Rs.14,17,55,892/-

4. The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles has, therefore, requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.4,11,09,000/- from out of the balance amount of Rs.14,17,55,892/- for meeting out the expenditure towards the payment of Old Age Pension and Family Pension to the weaver members and their families under the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme

during the year 2007-2008 as detailed below:-

4.	Amount required for meeting Family Pension to the newly 250 Beneficiaries (From the eligible period to April 2007 ) (250 x Rs.350 x12)	Rs.10,50,000/-

5. The Government , after careful examination, have decided to accept the request of the Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles. Accordingly, the Government sanction a sum of Rs.4,11,09,000/- (Rupees Four crores Eleven lakhs nine thousand only) from out of the balance interest amount of Rs.14,17,55,892/- for meeting out the expenditure as detailed at para 4 above towards the payment of Old Age Pension and Family Pension to the weaver members and their families during the year 2007-2008 under the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

7) The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles is directed to settle the claims of Old Age Pension and Family Pension as per the procedures laid down in G.O.Ms.No.53, Handlooms, Handicrafts, Textiles and Khadi Department dated 24.03.1999 and send a report to Government.

8. The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para - 5 above to the beneficiaries concerned.
