ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, orders were issued implementing the Self Insurance Scheme for Handloom Weavers.

2. In the Government Order second read above orders have been issued sanctioning the participation of the State Government in the newly introduced Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme for Handloom Weavers in

Tamil Nadu from the year 2004-2005 and to discontinue the existing Self Insurance Scheme for Handloom Weavers and to contribute in the premium structure on behalf of weavers under the Scheme. The premium structure under the Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme is as indicated below:-

Details of premium	Contribution / Weaver annum
Government of India contribution	Rs.150/-
State Government contribution	Rs.130/-
LIC of India contribution	Rs.100/-
Total premium	Rs.380/-

3. In the letter fourth read above, the Government of India have communicated revised Guidelines on 19.09.2005 for implementation of the "Mahatma Gandhi Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme" instead of "Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme" from the year 2005-2006 and reduced the weavers' contribution towards premium from Rs.130/- to Rs.80/-. The Executive Director, Life Insurance Corporation of India, Mumbai has informed that 1,17,220 Handloom weavers enrolled under Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme have been converted and enrolled under Mahatma Gandhi Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme from 02.10.2005 and the adjustment in premium (Rs.130 - 80 = 50) paid at the rate of Rs.130/- for earlier scheme (Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme) will be made during the year 2006-2007. Thus a sum of Rs.58,61,000/- was available from out of the amount sanctioned in the Government Order third read above with Life Insurance Corporation of India.

4. In the Government Order sixth read above, a sum of Rs.95,16,600/- after deducting a sum of Rs.58,61,000/- available with Life Insurance Corporation of India towards premium payable to Life Insurance Corporation of India in respect of 1,92,220 Handloom Weavers both within and outside the co-operative fold at the rate of Rs.80/- per weaver per annum under Mahatma Gandhi Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme for the year 2006-2007.

5. In the letter seventh read above, the Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles has now requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.1,53,77,600/- towards renewal of premium payable to Life Insurance Corporation of India under Mahatma Gandhi Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme for the year 2007-2008 on behalf of 1,92,220 Handloom Weavers both within and outside the co-operative fold.

6. The Government after careful consideration have decided to accept the proposal of the Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles. They accordingly, sanction a sum of Rs.1,53,77,600/- (Rupees One crore fifty three lakhs seventy seven thousand and six hundred only) towards renewal of premium payable to Life Insurance Corporation of India under Mahatma Gandhi Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme for the year 2007-2008 on behalf of 1,92,220 Handloom Weavers both within and outside the co-operative fold.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

8. Necessary additional provision of Rs.53,77,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2007-2008. Pending provision of funds, the Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles is authorized to draw the amount sanctioned in para 6 above and to pay the same to the Life Insurance Corporation of India on behalf of the Weavers under Mahatma Gandhi Bunkar Bima Yojana Scheme for the year 2007-2008 and he is responsible for the proper implementation of the Scheme. The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles is requested to include the additional amount while sending the proposal for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2007-2008 to Government in Finance Department without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.69991/Ind/07 dated 31.10.2007 and Additional Sanction Ledger Number 1170 (One Thousand one Hundred and Seventy).
