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ORDER:

The Tamil Nadu Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme is one of the Schemes being implemented for the welfare of Handloom Weavers. The members admitted under this scheme are contributing 8 paise (Eight paise) per rupee of wages earned and the State Government is contributing 4 paise per rupee of wages earned by each weaver. The Government of India contributes 4 paise as matching contribution under the Central Thrift Fund Scheme. The contributions of the above amount are deposited in the Government Account on which the Government of Tamil Nadu allows 9.5% interest. Out of 9.5% interest, 6.5% interest is credited into the weaver member's account and the remaining 3% interest is utilised for implementing the Old Age Pension Scheme, Family Pension Scheme and Health Package Scheme for Handloom Weavers.

2) The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles in his letter second read above, has stated that, a total sum of Rs.4,18,40,060/- is required towards 4% State Government's contribution for the implementation of Tamil Nadu Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme for the year 2007-2008 for 77,569 Handloom Weavers. He has, therefore, requested the Government to sanction the

above amount towards 4% State Government's contribution under the Scheme for the year 2007-2008.

3) The Government, after careful consideration, have decided to accept the request of the Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles. Accordingly, the Government sanction a sum of Rs.4,18,40,060/- (Rupees Four Crore Eighteen lakhs forty thousand and sixty only) towards 4% State Government's contribution for the implementation of Tamil Nadu Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme for the year 2007-2008.

4) The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 above shall be debited to:-

"2851 00 Village and Small Industries -103. Handloom Industries - Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan - II State Plan - KO. The Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme - 10 Contributions - 01 Contribution to Specific Fund".

5) Necessary additional provision of Rs.18,40,060/- (Rupees Eighteen lakhs forty thousand and sixty only) will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2007-2008. Pending provision of funds, the Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above. The Deputy Directors of Handlooms and Textiles / Assistant Directors of Handlooms and Textiles are authorized to draw and disburse the amount that may be sub-allocated in their circles by the Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles. The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles is requested to include the additional amount while sending the proposal for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2007-2008 to Government in Finance Department without fail.

6) The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles is also requested to instruct the Circle Deputy Directors of Handlooms and Textiles / Assistant Directors of Handlooms and Textiles to credit the weavers contribution in the Government account every month. The Commissioner of Handlooms and Textiles should send a report to Government in Finance Department every month, in this regard.

7) This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.69990/Ind/07 dated 01.11.2007 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1186 (One Thousand One Hundred and Eighty six)
