ORDER:

The Government of Tamil Nadu has introduced the Old Age Pension Scheme for Handloom Weavers in the co-operative fold from 01.04.1997. The members enrolled in the Savings and Security Scheme who attain the age of 60 years are eligible to get Old Age Pension of Rs.200/- per month. The Old Age Pension amount is paid from out of the 3% interest accrued under the Savings and Security Scheme.

2. While moving the Budget for the year 2007-2008, the Hon'ble Minister for Finance has announced, among other things, that the monthly pension given to handloom weavers above 60 years of age will be doubled from Rs.200 to Rs.400/- per month.

3. The Government, accordingly direct that the pension amount payable to the weaver members of the Tamil Nadu Weavers Co-operative Societies who are contributing to the Tamil Nadu Co-operative Handloom Weavers Savings and Security Scheme be enhanced from Rs.200/- to Rs.400/- per month with effect from 1.6.2007. All other terms and

conditions of the scheme mentioned in the Government Order first read above shall continue to be applied

4. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No. 148/DS(B)/2007 dated 31.05.2007
