ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above orders have been issued for the classification of Contractors, and levy of application fee and registration fee for Contractors in Highways Department as follows:

(i) Classification of Contractors:

Class I	Above Rs.25.00 Lakhs.
Class II	Upto Rs.25.00 Lakhs.
Class III	Upto Rs.10.00 Lakhs.
Class IV	Upto Rs.5.00 Lakhs.
Class V	Upto Rs.2.00 Lakhs.

(ii) Application Fees:

1.	Class V (Jurisdiction within territorial Division)	Rs.200/- (Rupees Two hundred only)
2.	Class IV, III, II and I (Jurisdiction within territorial Circle)	Rs.250/- (Rupees Two hundred and Fifty only)
3.	Class IV, III, II and I with State level Jurisdiction	Rs.500/- (Rupees Five hundred only)

(iii) Registration Fees:

1.	Class V (Territorial Division Jurisdiction)	Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only)
2.	Class IV, III, II and I (Territorial Circle Jurisdiction)	Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two thousand only)
3.	Class IV, III, II, I (State level Jurisdiction)	Rs.4000/- (Rupees Four thousand only)

2. In the Government Order second and third read above, Public Works Department has issued orders revising the classification, application fee and registration fees as follows:-

(a) Classification of Contractors:

Class I	above Rs.75.00 Lakhs.
Class II	Upto Rs.75.00 Lakhs.
Class III	Upto Rs.30.00 Lakhs.
Class IV	Upto Rs.15.00 Lakhs.
Class V	Upto Rs.6.00 Lakhs.

(b) Application Fee:

1.	Class V (Jurisdiction within Division level)	Rs.1000 (Rupees One Thousand only)
2.	Class V, IV, III, II and I (Jurisdiction at Circle level)	Rs.1000 (Rupees One Thousand only)
3.	Class V, IV, III, II and I (Jurisdiction at State level)	Rs.5000 (Rupees Five Thousand only)

(c) Registration Fees:

1.	Class V (Jurisdiction within Division level)	Rs.10,000 (Rupees Ten Thousand only)
2.	Class V, IV, III, II and I (Jurisdiction at Circle level)	Rs.20000 (Rupees Twenty thousand only)
3.	Class V, IV, III, II and I (Jurisdiction at State level)	Rs.50000 (Rupees Fifty Thousand only)

3. The Chief Engineer (General), Highways Department has stated that the classification of contractors, and application fee and registration fee for contractors, which are now being adopted in Highways Department were fixed as early as December 1992 and that during the past 15 years, the cost of the works and materials, have increased manifold. He has accordingly suggested change in classification, and revision of application fee and registration fee for contractors in tune with the increase and revision by Public Works Department. The Chief Engineer (General) has further

stated that the Board of Engineers in its 86th meeting held on 21.03.2007 resolved that the procedure followed in Public Works Department in respect of registration of contractors may be adopted in Highways Department and that necessary orders of Government may be obtained in this regard. The Chief Engineer (General) has, therefore, requested the orders of the Government for change in classification of contractors, and revision of application fee and registration fee for contractors as in the case of Public Works Department.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of Chief Engineer (General) in detail and decided to accept the same. Accordingly, the Government direct that the classification of contractors, and application fee and registration fee for contractors in Highways department shall be revised with immediate effect as given in the annexure to this order on the lines of the system adopted in Public Works Department.

5. The Government further direct that the Government Order be adopted with immediate effect and that the existing contractors be directed to comply with the revised norms.

6. The Government also direct that in future as and when the Public Works Department revises the classification of contractors, application fee and registration fees for contractors, the same shall be adopted in Highways Department as well.
