ORDER:

The Government have examined the proposal of the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Maritime Board to declare the shipbuilding yard to be developed by M/s. Goodearth Shipbuilding Private Limited at Silambimangalam between Reddiyarpettai and Pudukuppam in Cuddalore district as a minor port with the nomenclature as “**Silambimangalam Shipyard port**” and to extend the provisions of the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (Central Act XV of 1908) and the Tamil Nadu Maritime Board Act, 1995 (Tamil Nadu Act 4 of 1996) to this port and decided to accept it.
