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## **ORDER:**

The Vice Chairman and Chief Executive officer, Tamil Nadu Maritime Board in the letter read above has stated that the Board in its 62<sup>nd</sup> meeting held on 23.06.2009 has resolved to declare the Kaveri Port in Nagapattinam District as Captive Minor Port and to request the Government to issue necessary notification under the Indian Ports Act, 1908, (Central Act XV of 1908) in this regard

2. The Government have accordingly examined the proposal. They decided to accept the proposal and declare the Kaveri Port in Nagapattinam district as Minor Port by extending the provisions of the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (Central Act XV 1908) and the Tamil Nadu Maritime Board Act, 1995 (Tamil Nadu Act 4 of 1996) with port limits as specified in Notification-I appended to this order.

3. The Notifications appended to this order will be published in an Extra-ordinary issue of the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette and in the Nagapattinam District Gazette.
