ORDER

2. The Commissioner of Labour, in his letter third read above, has sent proposals for reconstitution of the above Tripartite Monitoring Committee for monitoring the implementation of the recommendations of Manisana Wage Board for the Working Journalists and Other Newspaper Employees.

3. The Government, after careful consideration, hereby reconstitute the Tripartite Monitoring Committee for monitoring the implementation of the recommendations of Manisana Wage Board for the Working Journalists and Other Newspaper Employees with the following members, namely:-

5. The Joint Commissioner of Labour (Conciliation), Office of the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai 600 006, is authorized to countersign the Travelling Allowance bills of the non-official members. The Administrative Officer (Minimum Wages) in the Office of the Commissioner of Labour, Chennai 600 006, is the drawing officer in respect of the traveling allowance for the non-official members of the Tripartite Monitoring Committee.

6. The expenditure towards the travel expenses shall be debited to the head of account:-
