ORDER:

The Director of Legal Studies in his letter read above has recommended to the Government to do away with the practice of transferring students from one Government Law College to another Government Law College on request or otherwise as it is not possible to give transfer to all the students who have applied for it and this results in unrest among the students who have not got such transfer. The students are admitted in a particular Government Law College based on the option of the students concerned and also with respect to the availability of the vacancy.

2. The Government, after considering the recommendations of the Director of Legal Studies, hereby order that students admitted in 3 year and 5 year Law degree courses in the Government Law Colleges in the State shall pursue and complete their course of study in the College in which they are originally allotted. No request for transfer of students from one Government Law College to another Government Law College will be entertained at any stage of their studies.

3. The Director of Legal Studies is directed not to effect transfer of student from one Government Law College to another Government Law College, on request or otherwise, unless directed by the Government to do so in any exceptional case.
