



## ABSTRACT

TNUDP III – Implementation of Under Ground Sewerage Scheme in Chinnamanur Municipality –Revised administrative sanction and sanction of additional Grant – Orders – issued.

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### ORDER:

In the G.O first read above, administrative sanction has been accorded for implementation of Under Ground Sewerage Scheme to Chinnamanur Municipality at an estimated cost of Rs. 10.16 crore.

2. In the letter second read above, the Director of Municipal Administration has stated that the Under Ground Sewerage Scheme for the Chinnamanur Municipality was taken up for implementation with the Administrative Sanction of the Government accorded in G.O.(3D) No. 6 MA&WS Department Dated. 02.03.2007 at an estimated cost of Rs. 10.16 crore. The Scheme was entrusted to the TWAD Board and taken up for implementation in 2 Packages i.e., Package 1 for Collection and Package 2 for STP with Activated Sludge Process (ASP) instead of the Waste Stabilization Pond Technology (WSP) sanctioned originally. The Director of Municipal Administration has furnished the following reasons for escalation of project cost:

1. Due to the tender excess both in Collection System and Sewerage Treatment Plant bids.
2. Due to the increase in payment to Highways Department and Road Restoration charges.
3. The claim of the contractor based on the price variation clause provided in the agreement.

3. The Director of Municipal Administration has stated that the proposed scheme is to be implemented under TNUDP-III with the revised financial tie up as follows:

4. The Director of Municipal Administration has also stated that the Municipal Council has resolved in its Resolution No.1026 dated. 27.11.2009 for the revised funding pattern as above. After completion of the scheme, the local body will maintain the scheme. The possibility for privatization will be explored including recycling of treated waste water for the industrial use.

5. The Director of Municipal Administration has recommended the revised proposal for the implementation of the comprehensive sewerage scheme for the Chinnamanur Municipality at an estimated cost of Rs.14.52 crore to install and Rs.0.46 crore to maintain annually for the present population and decided to go in for the revised financial assistance as recommended by the TNUDF. The Director of Municipal Administration has also stated that the proposal has been approved by the 7<sup>th</sup> meeting of the State Level Project Sanctioning Committee (SLPSC) held on 17.11.2009 and recommended to the Government for according Revised Administrative Sanction with the above funding pattern and Financial Operating Plan (FOP).

6. The Director of Municipal Administration has therefore requested the Government to accord the Revised Administrative Sanction for the implementation of the Under Ground Sewerage project in Chinnamanur Municipality at an estimated cost of Rs. 14.52 crore to install and Rs.0.46 crore to maintain annually and for the allocation of an additional grant of Rs. 8.01 crore, in relaxation of the Grant Fund Guidelines, considering the poor financial status of the Municipality.

7. The Government have carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Municipal Administration and the recommendation of the 7<sup>th</sup> State Level Project Sanctioning Committee (SLPSC) and hereby accord the Revised Administrative Sanction for the implementation of the Under Ground Sewerage project in Chinnamanur Municipality at an estimated cost of Rs. 14.52 crore to install and

Rs.0.46 crore to maintain annually and also sanction an additional grant of Rs. 8.01 crore under Grant Fund I of TNUDP III, in relaxation of the Grant Fund I Guidelines.
