ORDER:

The Officers of Government of India who are deputed for training are permitted to retain the residential telephone during their training period.

2. The question of extending the above facility to the State Government of Officers who are deputed for training has been examined by the Government and the Government have decided to extend these facilities to the State Government Officers. The Government accordingly direct that the following telephone facilities shall be provided to the State Government Officers and I.A.S., I.P.S., and I.F.S., Officers who are deputed for training subject to the following conditions :

- a). Residential telephone will be allowed to be retained by officers of the rank of Heads of Departments and above.
- b) The Government will bear the rental charges at Rs. 200/- for two months which includes 200 free calls.
- c) Any excess call charges will be borne by the Officer.
- d) The facility will be given for a period of one year.

3. The bills of the telephone should be settled in the first instance by the Department where the officer was working immediately prior to his being deputed for training and call charges over and above the free calls allowed by the Posts and Telegraphs Department also should be recovered by that department and credited into relevant head of account.

4. The request for retention of telephone should be sent the Deputy Secretary to Government , Public (Telephone-I) Department in such cases for issue of orders.

5. This order will come into effect from 1st October, 1984,
