



Telephones – Revised ceiling on free calls to the direct lines telephones functioning at the residence of certain Government officers –Orders- Issued.

ORDER:

In the G.O first read above, orders were issued prescribing ceiling on free calls to the residential telephones of various categories of Government officers in four groups. Based on the recommendation of High Level Committee on Economy Constituted in G.O. Ms, No., 660 Finance (BG-I) Dated 16.9.1993 the ceiling on free calls to the residential telephones of Government officers were revised in the G.O. second read above as detailed below:

	Categories	Ceiling	Officer entitled for the facility
1	Category - I	Total exemption (No ceiling on free calls)	High Dignitaries / Officials mentioned in Annexure I to the G.O. first read above.
2.	Category - II	2000 (Two thousand) Free calls bimonthly including the free calls allowed by Telephones Department	Secretaries to Government including Additional Secretaries to Government and other Officials given in Annexure II to the G.O. first read above
3.	Category- III	1000 (one thousand) Free calls bimonthly including the free calls allowed by Telephones Department	Certain H O D's / Gazetted Personal Assistants / Senior. P.A.s to Minister and other Officials given in Annexure III to the G.O. first read above
4.	Category- IV	600 (Six hundred) Free calls bimonthly including the free calls allowed by Telephones Department	All other officers who are not covered in Annexures I,II, and III to the G.O. first read above

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2. The Resident Audit Officer, Secretariat, has now stated that the number of free calls allowed to the residential telephones of Commissioner of Revenue Administration, Tamil Nadu Government Advocate on Record, Supreme Court, New Delhi, Commissioner of Police, Madras City, Superintendent of Police, the CID Wing, Director of Fire Services, Inspectors of Police, the CID Wing, have not been specified in the amendments to the Tamil Nadu Financial Code volume II issued by the Finance (Salaries) Department. He has also added that the post of Chairman and Vice Chairman Tamil Nadu Administrative Tribunal Madras, who have been totally exempted from payment of excess call charges vide, G.O.Ms. 90, Public (Telephones II) Department dated 29.1.1992 have not been indicated in the G.O. first read above. He has therefore requested to issue necessary clarification in this regard.

3. The Government have examined the proposal and have decided to issue the following amendment to the G.O. first read above.

AMENDMENT

In the Annexures to the G.O. Ms.No. 1578 Public (Telephones I) Department dated 19-8-1986 the following shall be added:
